

TESTING GOD'S WORD

The dictionary defines the word "test" as: "the means by which the genuineness of anything is determined..." Tests are often used to determine and prove the ability of something or someone. They also help confirm a person or thing's credibility and reliability. Tests are made in school and for jobs, but most importantly, in our faith journey.

Throughout the Bible, we see many examples of people who put God's word to the test. For instance, Prophet Elijah tested God by challenging 450 prophets of Baal to see which God would answer first (1 Kings 18:20-39), and when Gideon tested the Angel of the Lord to see if God's promise to deliver his people was true (Judges 6:6-40). They were not afraid to try the word of God, and when they did, they were not put to shame or left disappointed.

Throughout the Bible, God invites people to test His word multiple times. In Malachi 3:10, God said, "Try me now in this and see...' In other words, put my word to the test, and I will do just as I said I would. The lives of many Christians are stuck today, and they live in suffering because many have truly failed to put the word of God to the test. They are not bold in their faith and belief. This is what makes the difference between those who glorify God with their lives and those who accept to be just another person in the crowd.

GOD IS THE WORD


ecause of His holy character, God has always had high regard for spoken agreements, so much so that even though centuries have passed, the Word He gave us remains valid, faithful, and unchanging. He makes a point of fulfilling His Word.

Therefore, it is essential for God that we are people of our word. He demands it of us, for He would never accept that we don't keep our word. Looking back to the past, we will see that men used to keep their word. There was no need for a contract, a signature, or a notary. Someone's word was enough. Many of us can see this virtue in our parents and grandparents, but unfortunately, this has been lost recently. Men have failed to keep their word. They became people of bad character who can no longer be trusted.

We can see this in many marriages. People give their word on the altar, saying they will love each other, be faithful to each other until death, and always be together. However, what we see is an increasing number of divorces. It shows how

In Ezekiel 17:11-20, we can see how this is a requirement from God: We can see God's anger towards those who lie, deceive, and don't keep their word. By shaking the hand of the king of Babylon, his enemy, the king of Judah took an oath that he would not rebel against him. However, when the king of Babylon turned away, the king of Judah broke that covenant and angered God. Although the king's reasons could be fair, as he supposedly wanted to free Jerusalem, he gave his word and could not return on it.

If God did not accept this behavior from the king of Judah, even though the king of Babylon was his enemy, He wouldn't accept it when we pledge our word to Him. What does He expect from us when we promise Him faithfulness and obedience? What would be the consequences if we dishonor the word we gave before His altar? Meditate on it. Analyze yourself.

THIS IS FAITH

very effort that biomedical scientific researcher Reinaldo Manhani made to make his life different from the problematic family situation he experienced as a child did not generate permanent results. At the same time, he depended solely on his knowledge. He believed that through studies, his story would be different from that of his family.

As a teenager, I started working during the day and studying at night. I completed a university education that, at the time, 30 years ago, was almost impossible for my social condition. Soon after completing the biomedicine course, I sought out prospecting for my profession at the Hospital as an intern. I embarked on a booming professional career there. That's when I met my wife, and we had two children.

I achieved the stability I had dreamed of:

- A family.
- A successful career.
- Medical research articles published with international repercussions.
 - Purchasing power, among others.

Conflicts in my marriage, however, made me a frustrated man. Therefore, I focused all my dedication on fatherhood to be "the father I wished I had" for my children. I created a strong emotional bond with them.

After ten years, the marriage ended, and by law, custody of the children remained with my ex-wife. I couldn't accept the distance and the new scenario, which was going from a caring father to a visiting father. I went into severe depression and started undergoing treatment. I used controlled medications and underwent psychotherapy with prominent professionals in the field, but it didn't help. With the loss of my family and depression, my health deteriorated, which led me to become unemployed.

One day, trying to tune in to a radio station, I heard the program of the Universal Church and became interested. After hearing it again a few more days, I attended a church meeting. I began regularly participating in meetings but questioned everything I



heard, including the testimonies. Until I understood that my life resulted from not putting God first, I realized that all my efforts and scientific knowledge were limited and that I would not get anywhere with the strength of my arm. I decided to live the faith in an intense, genuine way, without questioning, to overcome all prejudices and pride and surrender to the teachings from the Altar. I learned to practice intelligent faith.

Because I understood the position that God should occupy in my life, it was not difficult for me to test with God. After surrendering to the Altar, I understood that the next step was obedience to have a genuine relationship with the Most High.

My life began to show the results of this obedience to the Word of God. I threw myself body, soul, and spirit into faith. The closer I got to the Altar and faith, the more I saw results. I realized that I was really on the right path. Little by little, new doors opened, and my life is wholly restored today. I specialized in personalized medicine for cancer treatment.

I am now free of depression, my two children, now young adults, are a source of joy, and I overcame all the frustration in my love life by getting married again. I can say that the windows of the heavens that opened transformed my life and gave me God's direction, thoughts, and vision. When we put God first, we trust He is in control and guides our life.



Doctors found a cyst in one of his kidneys when carrying out tests. "The cyst was huge, and my rock bottom began there."

Enderson was diagnosed with a Bosniak cyst, a benign tumor up to level 2. In Enderson's case, the cyst was level 3. Specialists confirmed the malignancy: he had cancer.

He sought help from several doctors, who all said the solution would be to remove the organ. There was no possibility of chemotherapy sessions, for example. "The suggested complete kidney removal, but there was a risk of death. Hoping to find some good news, I started looking for other into a deep depression. doctors," he says.

Enderson was desperate. He consulted with nine renowned doctors from the best hospitals in the city. He had a significant expense paying for private consultations.

Claudia grew up without mother's attention, and since childhood, she felt rejected by her father, abandoned who family. Everton also grew up without his father's presence, and his mother cared for him and his five siblings alone. As a result, Claudia had no reference on how to be a wife, and Everton had no reference on how to be a husband and father.

They met when they were teenagers: Everton was 16, and Claudia was 14. Even without Claudia's mother's consent, they decided to live together after two months of dating. It was then that the problems between the two began. "As he was very young, he didn't work, and he already had a cocaine addiction. So, he was

t's difficult for a person involved with drug dealing, and I joined this life to please him. I put all my strength and hope in him because, since childhood, I felt rejected. So, I accepted his aggression, betrayal, and insults because I thought it would be worse without him," reveals Claudia.

> The couple decided to change cities to escape bad friendships and live a new life. Still, the attempt was unsuccessful, as, despite the new location, they both maintained the same behavior. In addition to their troubled relationship, they also had to deal with the arrival of a baby in the family. "My son grew up seeing our fights and his father's betrayals. There was a lack of union, conversation, companionship, fidelity, and everything else in a healthy relationship. We lived a life of failures, and I felt very alone," says Claudia.

One day, Everton left home, and soon after, Claudia began participating in Love Therapy meetings in the Universal Church. When participating in the lectures,



she realized the relationship nullified: "I had no life because he was my life. So, I could look inside myself and heal my wounds because I felt a lot of pain towards him because of his betrayals. I gave God my marriage and fear of losing Everton, which previously led me to subject myself to anything."

Seeing his wife's change, Everton also attended the lectures: "In the lectures, I learned that I needed to sacrifice the single life. I left the addictions, the women, and the clubs. Now I am a man who honors his wife because I am faithful."

For about two years, the couple has been experiencing a new phase: "We converse, we are companions, and we trust each other," says Claudia.

"I discovered real and true love with the Lord Jesus. Today, I love Everton, but he is not above God in my life," concludes Claudia.

Of course, there were difficult moments, but they pushed themselves throughout these four months.


Instead of acting out in a negative way like they used to, they dealt with the situations with self-control, as they learned through the



us in essman Rodrigo Fernandes has always been an independent person. At 17, he left home to live alone and seek financial growth. "I always found it easy to make money, but I lost everything just as easily." After he married his wife, Solange Fernandes, they started to have many problems, especially financial difficulties. "I didn't have a family growing up; I was an orphan. I believed I could build a family with him, but that didn't happen," she recalls.

The couple chose to live in Rodrigo's father's house without money. Sometime later, they built a house in the community and moved out to a dangerous location. The couple already had two daughters and needed to protect them inside their home, which was a constant target of stray bullets.

Rodrigo became a seller of smuggled products. He started organizing prostitution parties, got involved with the local gangs, and began carrying weapons, causing fear in the community. Furthermore, he frequently cheated on his wife. "When I called, he was with other women and wanted to

ensure I knew that. I heard the lover's laugh. He didn't care."

Solange was tired of this situation, so she went to The Universal Church for a solution. "I told God I wanted to be happy," she says.

Thanks to her participation in the meetings, Solange began to change, and this caught the attention of Rodrigo, who could no longer take the life he was living. "I told my wife I wanted to serve the same God she served. I no longer wanted to be that Rodrigo."

When he arrived at the Church, he understood he needed to get delivered. "Everything the pastor said seemed like it was for me as if he already knew my life," says Rodrigo.

The couple began attending meetings, and the restoration became visible. Rodrigo abandoned the life he had and finally regained his desire to prosper. For him, all this change is due to faith. "God gave me the Holy Spirit, freed and transformed me. Nothing I have is mine. Everything is from Him and for Him," he concludes.
