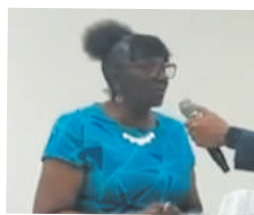
“My cousin was healed from heart attacks, stroke, and cancer.”

Because of the problems that I was facing, I just wanted to run away and forget about it all. At 14, I got married thinking that I would be happy this way, but I was wrong; that only made things worse.

My husband used to drink a lot, and there was no peace in our home. Any simple thing that happens would be a reason for us to fight. The fights were so violent to the point that I started contemplating suicide. I tried to end my life several times. I thought of hanging myself, and at one point, I took seventy tablets, but still, I survived.

One night, as we were fighting, I took up a gun because I could not take it anymore, and I decided to end it all. When he saw me with a weapon, he came and tried to take it away from me as he saw that I had pointed the gun at my belly. He tried to pull it out from me, and I was pulling at the same time, and in this fight, the gun went off and damaged my arm. I was rushed to the hospital, where I stayed for 42 days, and went through 6 surgeries to try to save my arm.

One day, as my daughter was playing outside, something strange happened, and her face became swollen and dark. It was a work of witchcraft that I heard was being done against me but ended up affecting my daughter instead. From that day, she started

hearing voices and seeing shadows, and her skin was itchy. As a mother, I felt terrible, and knowing that I was not able to help her, the desire to die only increased. I thought that this was the only way to stop suffering.

When I was in the most bottomless pit, in despair, I remembered the invitation I had received from the Universal Church and decided to call. I come from a background where we did not believe in God but in different images. Still, since I needed help, I decided to go to the Universal Church. When

I went there, I felt peace and assurance that there was hope for me. I, therefore, decided to continue coming to the church. I started my Chain of Prayer every Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday, and the more I came, the better I felt. From a young age, Davina Nunez was a family-orientated child, but that changed when her father passed away when she was just six. The effects of his death made me develop a negative outlook on life. On top of this, she started having spiritual attacks.

Before attending the Universal Church and coming to know God, my life was destroyed. At the age of 12, I began to notice things in me that were not normal for a young child. I was sad and cried a lot for no reason. At school, I always had a smile, but when I was alone, tears rolled down my face. So, I began listening to black metal music, the only music that “calmed” me during those moments of loneliness. Sometime later, I discovered that this genre of music had strong ties to Satanism. So, I decided to take it upon myself to be a follower of Satan.

I grew up with this mindset. With each day that passed, the ideas linked to Satanism grew in my mind. My hair was long, and I always wore black. I only had a few friends like me, so I decided to write songs that spoke against churches. When I sang, my voice sounded like the voice of an evil spirit. I would cut my hands to see the blood run out of the cuts, and then I would drink my blood and smear it on my eyes and the satanic medal I carried

around my neck. I would transform.

I smoked and drank a lot with my friends. My family was being destroyed because of me; my mother especially suffered a lot. But my mother began attending the Universal Church. She decided to fight for me because she did not accept that situation. She revolted against the evil that was in my life. I remember saying to her: “Nobody is going to change me. This is who I am, and this is how I will be forever”. But there was a conviction inside her, and she was sure I would change and accept God.

After much perseverance and participating in Chains of prayers on my behalf, my mother received an answer: I changed! My mindset started changing, and I put that life of darkness behind me. Today, I am a new person. I was delivered from addictions, depression, and Satanism. I stopped hanging around with the wrong crowd and am no longer attracted to evil. SPIRITUAL ATTACKS

Indicators of Spiritual Attack:

- **Draining vitality**
A sudden, unexplained energy depletion or constant fatigue can signal a spiritual attack. It feels as if your energy reserves are persistently low despite adequate rest.
- **Emotional Turmoil**
Unusual mood swings, heightened anxiety, or waves of depression inconsistent with your usual emotional state may indicate a spiritual attack.
- **Social Withdrawal**
Pulling back from social engagements or relationships without clear cause could signify a spiritual attack, creating an invisible barrier between you and your social world.
- **Health Setbacks**
Unexpected health challenges or a sudden decline in well-being, despite a healthy lifestyle, may suggest a spiritual attack, as if an unseen force is undermining your physical resilience.
- **Unexplained Anxiety**
An overwhelming, unfounded sense of fear or anxiety interfering with daily life could be a manifestation of a spiritual attack.
- **Invisible Energy Drain**
Persistent fatigue or

unexplained loss of vitality may indicate a spiritual attack as if an invisible force were draining your energy.

- **Endless Struggles**
Recurring conflicts or internal battles that resist resolution may reflect a spiritual struggle, hindering your growth and energy.

- **Reverting to Old Patterns**
Being drawn back to old habits or addictions during times of stress or spiritual turmoil may indicate attempts to derail life progress.

- **Absence of Peace**
Restlessness, confusion, and discontent disrupting your peace could signify a spiritual attack.

- **Overwhelming Despair**
A pervasive feeling of hopelessness or emotional drain, disproportionate to life circumstances, may indicate a spiritual attack.

- **Stubborn Obstacles**
Persistent challenges beyond ordinary setbacks, affecting both external circumstances and internal state, suggest a spiritual attack, requiring resilience and faith in action to overcome.

THE VOICES TOLD HER TO HURT HERSELF

Since childhood, 27-year-old Alexandra has had problems, such as hearing voices telling her to hurt herself or someone else. As time went by, she began to see shadows and experience panic attacks and depression.

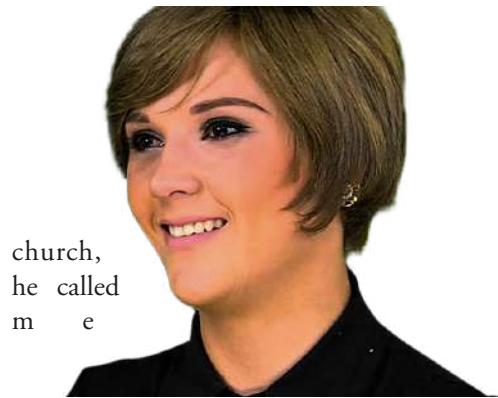
At 15, she started living with urban rock and black metal groups. At the same time, she discovered drugs, such as marijuana, cocaine, and alcoholic beverages. "I saw they had the same problems as me in these groups, so I said that was where I belonged. They introduced me to the false relief of drugs. When I used drugs, the panic I felt became cool."

Soon, Alexandra discovered Satanism. "Black metal is considered a praise to Satan. If someone did me harm, I had to destroy them because whoever was in Luciferianism, like me, was a 'sacred being.'"

The panic attacks became more intense, to the point where Alexandra had attacks anywhere. Drug use also intensified. "I saw the walls in the room were different colors and suffered from shortness of breath. As much as I was afraid of dying, I only stopped snorting cocaine when it ran out," she points out.



Once, a friend from a group she was also a member of introduced her to the Universal Church. "He had leukemia, and on the first day he went to



church, he called me

saying he had been baptized and something supernatural had happened."

She went and, during the meetings, sought the Holy Spirit.

"I understood that my emptiness caused all the internal problems. Just as I unquestioningly trusted the devil, it couldn't be any different with God. I gave my whole life to Him."

She was free from addictions and spiritual problems, and God filled her inner self.

"Before, I was afraid of the future and no longer saw joy in life. Now, I know I can achieve great things. I have the power of God within me," she concludes.

Because of these attacks, I found it difficult to sleep during the night. Nightmares were a constant part of my sleep: I dreamt of dead relatives, snakes, and other animals chasing me, and sometimes I would be drowning.

These dreams made me suicidal and depressed. On top of this, I would feel tired and weak during the day. To make matters worse, I had no stability in my life; I would always move from job to job and change addresses. Although I went to university, my grades were not the best. It made it difficult for me to find a good job.

Because I couldn't sleep, I decided to spend my nights at clubs. I sought help from various people and institutions. Running out of options, I had planned to visit a palm reader. But a friend of mine advised me not to go because my problems could have become worse. At one stage, my spiritual attacks intensified. This time, it felt as though someone was strangling me.

I discovered the church when I found a leaflet on a train at the subway station. When I read

it, it was exactly what I was looking for.

During my time at the Universal Church, I participated in numerous sessions, including the Friday meetings. On a Friday meeting, I determined that my situation would improve—and it did! That night, I went to sleep with no problems. From that night up until today, I have been totally free from spiritual attacks.

Now I help others; I own my own tire business and, most of all, I enjoy sleeping like a baby thanks to God and the Universal Church." - Frederick Lubwama

JOSEPH'S TESTIMONY OF FORGIVENESS

I was struggling with a grudge that I had kept for over 19 years against my brother-in-law. My sister was brutally taken away from me and my family, which occurred in front of her children around the age of three or four. I was in Junior high school then, and they told me to see the principal.

I was the first one to get notified of the news. But I couldn't believe it at the time, and all these feelings started to overwhelm me with resentment, anger, and hatred. And I knew something was wrong but couldn't put my finger on it.

A part of this course spoke about forgiveness, and all these emotions came to me. The thought came, "Hey, you need to forgive somebody." Still, I did not know who at the time; one day after class, I spoke to the bishop about what happened, and he told me to pray about it; for a week, I kept praying about it. To see if I could find some peace in my heart, I prayed last night, and I heard myself saying, "Bernard, I forgive you. I can't forget what you have done, but I forgive you to my brother-in-law." It was an emotional roller coaster; it hit me like many bricks. I couldn't fathom that I just forgave this man for killing my sister, I forgave this dude for traumatizing my niece and nephew, and I said to myself the next day, "I forgive you." I felt a lot of weight coming from my chest, which was peaceful. If I were to see my brother-in-law now, I would hug him.



While in seg, my friend Hailey let me use her tablet to watch Pando. My friend and I started praying with Bishop Bira Joshua and became prayer partners. Watching and praying with Bishop Bira Joshua on the Pando App has helped me release anxiety; I have been able to trust God's process and plan, and I have more faith.

My friend and I are also helping each other grow spiritually, ensuring we are spiritually full and not hungry in our faith. Now I am down with UBB!

An inmate stated that she had PTSD. While scrolling on her tablet one night, she saw the

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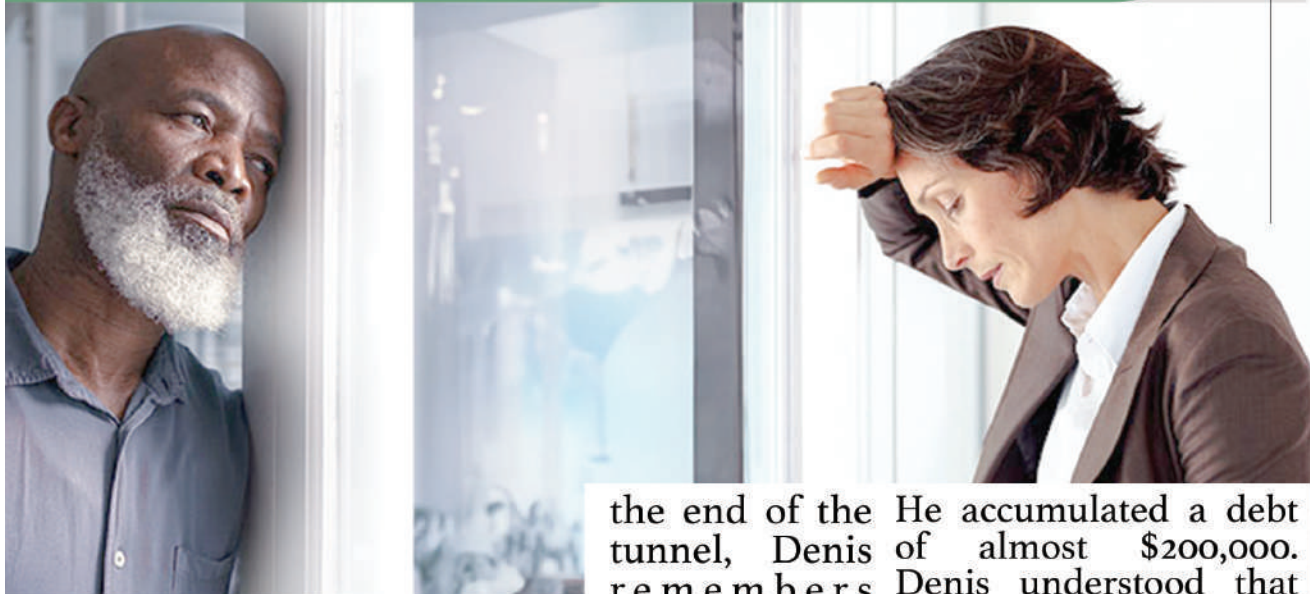

leading to frequent arguments with his wife. Furthermore, the businesses he tried to develop were not successful. As a result, he was overcome with negative thoughts and compared himself to others. Complaining was frequent in his daily life. "I victimized myself. I even began to doubt the existence of God. I fought about everything and always wanted to resolve things without

thinking first," he comments.

However, the more he complained, the worse the situation got. "My condition was so bad that when my salary was deposited into my account, it only served to cover the debt with the bank. I even opened an account at another bank so I could at least have some of my salary to buy the basics," he recalls.

Without seeing the light at the

end of the tunnel, Denis remembers that his wife invited him to a meeting at The Universal Church. He started going, but still, he didn't change his behavior. When his projects would work out, he forgot about God. When problems arose again, he immediately ran to Him and asked for a way out; he stated: "I treated God like my waiter. I thought things had to be my way, and when they didn't, I started complaining again."

He accumulated a debt of almost \$200,000. Denis understood that he needed to stop running away from reality. "I decided to obey everything God said and asked for his direction. I started to make smart decisions, especially when negotiating my debts, and always acted honestly. So, miracles started happening," he says.

Denis's story is a testament to the power of transformation. He stopped dwelling on problems and started taking action, guided by Divine wisdom. By reorganizing his priorities, he began to experience true prosperity. "I put God first and then my family. I am a completely different person, with a happy family and a prosperous life. But above all, I have found inner peace," he assures.

Denis Souza (photo below), aged 39, lived in a financial desert for several years, which he

he could only overcome after he understood that he needed to stop complaining and take responsibility for his actions. He comments that he was always proud and did not take responsibility for his actions. Denis focused on being successful in the financial and professional aspects, and even after starting his family, his priority continued to be making money. His wishes always came first, but this caused him to have more problems.

He began dedicating himself to working many hours daily but could not stabilize his financial life. Surprisingly, he went into debt. He reveals the reason for this: "I was totally unbalanced.
