Curse of Depression

Depression is neither a fatality nor a condemnation. Depression is the state of despair in the soul. Unfortunately, the depressed do not see that depression is a problem of the soul. And the more acute the level of depression, the greater the cry of the soul in search of help.

Symptoms of Depression

Imagine the person, at a particular moment, deciding to throw away everything good at home. As you look around, you notice the empty house and think to yourself: "I have nothing, I'm going to be in misery, I have no future, there's no hope for me, I'm lost, and I see no way out but death..."

The feeling of profound emptiness is the worst pain of the depressed. The symptoms of depression begin with doubt, then comes fear, emptiness, deep sadness, and agony, and it goes around.

Why are you Depressed?

s faith brings life, doubt brings death. While faith stimulates dreams and hopes and raises self-esteem, doubt poisons dreams and hopes and promotes depression.

I doubt there is medicine that cures depression, as well as I also doubt that anyone practicing faith in the Word of God is depressive. From a spiritual point of view, depression is nothing more than a permanent state of doubt. I'm not an expert in conventional medicine, but I know the spiritual. Depression is a strictly spiritual problem.

What medicinal drug is capable of curing a spiritual illness? How many people commit suicide after depressive crises? And what have Freudian philosophies done to reverse this picture? Nothing. Why? If the problem is of spiritual origin, its solution is also spiritual. When it comes to a spiritual problem, there is no way to avoid appealing to faith.

Usually, when talking about faith, the unwary thinks immediately of the practice of some religion. That's where they're wrong! Biblical faith has absolutely nothing to do with any religion or the like. The Bible dispenses with any religion. In the biblical faith, you find Spirit and Life. Spirit and life that flows from the Source of Life.

Humans are a trinity: body, soul, and spirit. As the body needs physical care, and the soul needs love, only the Spirit of God's Word (Bible) can nourish the human spirit. If the human spirit is not fed, the person feels A HOLE INSIDE

Modeling and dancing have always been my passions; when I got to do both, it was like a dream come true. I succeeded in my career, traveling to different countries and meeting others. I was in interviews and lived a life I always dreamt of. I had money, my apartment, and three bank accounts, and I lacked nothing.

After some time, I started having pains in my legs. At first, I thought it was nothing, but as time passed, the pains began to affect my work as a model and a dancer. I went to different doctors and specialists, but none could find the problem; they said ev-

perous life, everything suddenly got dark; I could not understand what was happening to me. Apart from the pain medications, I had to take depression pills, which also did not help. I didn't want to see the light of day anymore; I stayed in a dark room for two months. I became suicidal and thought that it was the only way to end the pain in my soul.

I felt that all my dreams were over; I didn't believe in anything anymore, life lost its color, and I had no more hope; I had no reason to live anymore; therefore, one day, I took all the pills that I had in an attempt to end my life, and I ended up in hospital. When I came out, life was just the same, and five months after, I attempted suicide again, and this time, my friend found me and took me to the hospital again. The doctors said that it was a miracle that my life was saved.

Suddenly, there was a deep sadness inside of me. I was in anguish, and I would cry uncontrollably. I had no control over my emotions, and I became aggressive; I was always ready to fight. From such a beautiful and prosperous life, everything suddenly got dark; I could not understand what was happening to me.

With time, I started losing jobs, and since there was no more income, my resources were being depleted. Little by little, I saw my life going down; I had financial issues, like returned checks and unpayable credit card bills. I lost my job and the money; I started losing weight and felt ugly; life lost its color in my life. I felt hopeless and helpless and didn't know what to do.

This situation made me depressed. Suddenly, there was a deep sadness inside of me. I was in anguish, and I would cry uncontrollably. I had no control over my emotions, and I became aggressive; I was always ready to fight. From such a beautiful and pros-

After these two attempts, I heard about the Universal Church, and even though I had always said that I would never go there, I decided to take this opportunity since I had nothing else to lose. I felt hope the first day I went to the Universal Church and heard the Word from the pastor. It was like I had the strength to fight again. I, therefore, decided to start the chain of prayer for my deliverance from the sickness and the depression. I obeyed everything that I heard and committed to God. In turn, I received the total deliverance: I am no longer sick, I am no longer depressed, and life got back its color in my life. God has restored everything I lost to me, and even better, I am happy and live to serve My Lord.

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DEPRESSION

It affects more than 300 million people around the world and is the second leading cause of suicide.

A ccording to the World Health Organization (WHO), more than 280 million people worldwide suffer from depression. Despite this alarming fact, unfortunately, many still see this mental disorder as laziness, idleness, or even a lack of character.

Clinical psychologist Lilian Gonzalez explains that depression can be triggered by various stressful factors such as the death of a loved one, financial problems, loss of a professional career, existential questions, taking medications, hormonal changes, and diagnosis of a severe illness, among others. "Some symptoms can help us identify the disease, but the diagnosis can only be given by a field professional," she attests.

Depression is the fourth leading cause of suicide among people 15–29-year-olds and causes around 700,000 deaths per year. Maybe you have depression or live with someone who does and doesn't even know it. (Source:www.who.int/ news-room/fact-sheets/detail/depression)

Ten spiritual symptoms of depression

•Constant irritation: getting angry is normal at different times in life, but being perpetually angry is a sign that something is wrong

•Difficulty concentrating: the difficulty or even inability to concentrate, understand, or do something, no matter how simple it may be

•Persistent low mood: this persistent lack of desire to do

things, even when surrounded by family and friends who value you, or the lack of willingness to participate in a special event

•Chest tightness/anguish/sadness: you cry for no reason, there is apathy in your eyes, and even simple tasks seem to be extremely painful. Sometimes everything seems fine, but there is a constant feeling of suffocation

•Suicidal thoughts: if this feeling of frustration and loneliness from the past, present, and future continues for a long term, the person may believe the lie that death will be a relief from the pain in the soul

•Lack of perspective: when depression sets in, there is a feeling that nothing and no one can help. It seems that the losses suffered are irreversible

•Lack of interest: when disinterest appears in a generalized way in life, family, work, and people, this is serious and worrying

•Excessive hunger or lack of appetite: some people report an excessive desire to eat that does not go away even after eating. Others say they have completely lost their appetite and the pleasure of eating. •Lack or excess sleep: difficulty falling asleep or waking up and being unable to fall asleep again. The head is full of worries, anxieties, and fears. If, for any reason, you are not able to sleep, then depression has already set in.

uísa Feliciano da Veiga says she was a happy child who led an deveryday life. She went to school, had friends, played, enjoyed attending church with her mother, and had a healthy relationship with her family. At the age of 13, however, the death of her grandmother caused the first signs of depression to emerge and were noticed by the family. "I started to have a lot of bad feelings, and I didn't understand why God had allowed my grandmother to die because I grew up in the church; I saw a lot of people being healed, and she wasn't. Since then, I started to close myself off and ask a lot of questions; I even had doubts about the existence of God; I lost my faith and started to harbor a lot of hurt," she says.

Her mother, Regina, reveals that her daughter was always by her side, and they were companions. During her adolescence, Luisa began to isolate herself. Luisa says that she stayed awake all night; during the day, she slept so as not to have contact with her family and spent several days without seeing them. At 18, she entered the worst phase of depression, as she had hallucinations and anxiety attacks, felt worms crawling through her body, and was unable to go to school. And, despite going to therapy and taking medication, nothing resolved her situation. Faced with this and because she thought there was no solution for her life, Luisa attempted suicide. The attempt failed, but the thoughts of death remained constant.

She was 21 when her mother noticed a swelling on her neck. "As if the depression wasn't enough, Luisa started to have more health problems. I found it very strange, and when I realized this, I took her to the emergency room. After

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
carrying out the assessment, the doctor told me that Luisa could not leave the hospital, as she had a malignant nodule in her neck and that it was Hodgkin's lymphoma," says Elis.

Luisa cried when she received the news and revealed that, as she always planned her death, she saw it as a way to die. "Then I realized that it didn't matter how I died since I would go to hell anyway if I died without getting rid of the thoughts and feelings I had and, above all, without accepting Jesus," she says.

Despite suffering an initial impact due to the news of Luisa's illness, Regina's reaction began a miracle: "I went home and felt my world fell apart, but I knew I had to do something, that I had to act on my faith, and I spoke to God: 'I don't know how the Lord will act, but I know that what I do will be the best for Luisa."

Regina points out that she didn't just want her daughter's cure but her salvation. So, she sought God at her home, where she left confident. "The fight, however, did not end there. It continued," she highlights. **A+10** ch

As the expected results from the procedures did not initially occur, the treatment had to be more aggressive, and Luisa was hospitalized for a month. She details what her experience was like: "I started to see my hair fall out, I started to feel weak, and the chemotherapy made me feel sick. I still had cancer, but something inside me was happening, and





today, I know that it was the response to my mother's sacrifice. This was very strong because I spent my whole life living with the desire to die, and suddenly, I was there with cancer. My body was dying, but life was being born inside me." One day, when she was alone in the hospital room, Luisa decided to give herself to the Lord Jesus.



When Luisa left the hospital, a Campaign of Faith took place at the Universal Church, and, like her mother, she gave herself entirely to the Altar. "I knew there was a worse cancer, which was cancer of the soul, depression, because I spent my entire life fighting it. But this time, I didn't just want physical health because I already had it before and didn't take advantage of it. I wanted to have the Spirit of God within me. That was my request." That day,

Luisa suffered so much from the pain that she almost couldn't climb the Altar. "When I got down, the pain went away," she comments. That was a sign that her prayer had been heard, and she continued seeking the Presence of God.

One day, in the same room where she suffered so much from the anguish of depression while reading the Bible, Luísa began to pray.

"I was honest like I had never been before, and at that moment, I was sure. It was like God was hugging me. I received a joy that I had never had before. Even though I was bald and swollen because of the treatment, I thought I looked beautiful. I remember that the first person I went to hug was my mother, and as soon as I opened the door, she realized that I had received the Holy Spirit. God did complete healing within me, which started from the inside out. First, it was the healing of the soul, which was the most urgent, and then the physical healing of cancer," she explains.

"Today, Luisa is cured. She repeated all the tests and did everything the doctor asked her to do. She received physical and spiritual healing, and a new Luísa is here, thank God," says her mother.






A notable highlight was the help of the UBB and YPG volunteers to assemble the furniture that the UBB sponsors donated to the inmates'

The main character would tell God, "No, I I'm not letting the past go." She would tell God with her lips, "Come back," God would say to her, 'What about this person or this friend who you told me you'd let go?

What about the party and everything else? She would say to God, "Oh yeah, okay, God and then return to the world afterward. In the end, God says you might as well take all of it back because it's like it's all or nothing with God. Apart from the play, the YPG danced, and together, the ladies at the Hobby Unit joined in for a fun time dancing.



Bishop Bira had the opportunity to do the "Straight Talk" podcast with some inmates. We had the open call service with approximately 400 inmates.

In the service, there was talk of "Never Again" (Psalm 1:1-6). The family made prayers, and the prayer was to cancel the sentence. During the meeting, we had many testimonies of the inmates who made the 21 days of Daniel's fast. We distributed Bibles and books in English and Spanish to those who still needed them. At the end of the meeting, the volunteers were available to those who would like to receive care and prayers.

What is the secret behind and success financial, professional, and personal fulfillment? Studies, opportunities, and years of effort and dedication? These choices are undoubtedly crucial, but imagine what can happen when the first option is faith in God and a pact with Him.

usinessman Fabrizio Yoshimitsu Matsumoto, 39, who has had a difficult life since childhood, can answer this question. "We lived in a rented house, which rained more inside than outside. Once, there was a shootout in the street, and we had to throw ourselves on the ground, as the wall was made of old wood. We left this house," he recalls.

The change in environment, however, did not mean better living conditions. "We went to live in an apartment, which would be paid off in 21 years, and we thought everything would get better, but then my parents separated. My first official job was at a fast-food store. I was a cashier and earned just over \$300. I stopped studying early and had no expectation of a promising future," he says.

Fabrizio arrived at The Universal Church in debt and suffering from panic attacks and depression. He was healed, but as he did not fully obey the Word of God, he still lacked inner peace. "My wife separated from me because I was still insecure, jealous, and possessive. At that time, we lived in a small back room in a backyard with several houses.

We paid a partial amount of the rent with great struggle, to the point where we had to 'hide because we couldn't pay the full rent."



He already understood that change would come through a pact with the Word of God. He learned that at the "Strong Nation" meetings on Mondays at The Universal Church. "I expressed my faith and signed this The pact. first change occurred within me. I started to have confidence, strength, courage, and vision. He knew everything that would work out if he practiced what he saw through faith. I learned through a pact with God and faithfulness that wherever I would place my feet and,

even if there was no ground, God would make a way for me," he says.

He tells how he learned to exercise faith even without having the perfect conditions to do so. "I started a business with no money; I worked in a restaurant, and customers asked me to come to their house. I started an event company that served celebrities and people in the media. My life started to change. I bought some items and paid off my debts. God placed confidence within me, and my relationship was restored, too; I married my wife again."

For him, the pact made with God made all the difference. "Every time I attended a meeting, I left stronger, full of certainty, and with a different outlook. We have our family, our house, and a restaurant, and I continue with my events company." Today, Fabrizio's life is completely transformed and blessed.
