The size of faith

esus censured the disciples' little faith before the great tempest (Matthew 8:26). Again when they lacked the faith to set a boy free, He said to them, "If you have faith as a mustard seed [...] nothing will be impossible for you" (Matthew 17:20).

How can we measure faith? How big must my faith be for me to achieve my dreams or conquer the promises of God?

The Lord compared the size of faith to a mustard seed because, among the rabbis, the mustard seed was commonly used to illustrate something very small. The size of a mustard seed is about the diameter of human hair, but a mustard tree grows up to 5 meters tall.

An act of faith pleases God. When Jesus saw a widow place everything she had on the altar, He considered her offering more valuable than all the other offerings put together.

Quantity is not a synonym for quality, especially regarding faith. The rich offered what was left over, representing their "leftover" faith.



But the widow gave all she had. In other words, she deposited all her faith in God's provision; she would depend exclusively on the Almighty. This quality of faith draws God's attention and shows its size.

The size of our faith is directly related to how dedicated we are to God because faith is an attitude of total dependence on God. The more we depend on Him, the bigger our faith is. The less we rely on Him, the smaller our faith is. Unbelief means independence from God. The more independent from God a person is, the more of an unbeliever he becomes.

was going to church for many years but had no relationship with God. From a spiritual point of view, I considered myself a fraud. I wore a mask, and I was a character within the church. I would answer people, 'Yes, ma'am,' 'Yes, sir,' I would smile at everyone, pretend to pray in meetings, and get involved in all the activities in the church. Still, I never fulfilled the vows that I vowed. It was all part of the character I created for myself.

No one knew the real me. I was an ut-

terly disturbed person; I had horrible nightmares, felt hatred, and enjoyed watching videos of people being murdered and horror films that showed blood. Many times, when I felt empty, I would bite myself and hit myself in places that no one could see. However, to those close to me, I showed the persona of a good person who went to church.

I discovered the Universal Church when I was a child, and, as a teenager, I was more interested in friendships, not God. I had surgery in which I had 20 pins inserted in my spine and, in addition to the emptiness that I didn't know how to deal with, I also had an inferiority complex, so I tried to fill myself with friends, music, and TV shows. However, no matter how hard I tried, nothing worked. It was all just a momentary pleasure.

In college, I met my husband and put my faith and trust in him. I thought he would change my life. We had an unstable relationship, but we decided to get married. I was married and had friends and family, but I still felt extremely alone. I started not sleeping well and had thoughts of suicide. In truth, I didn't understand what I needed because, in my religious mind, I had God since I attended church. However, I felt great pain and loneliness all the time. I was cold, manipulative, spiteful, proud, sad, and empty.

One Word made me open my mind, and my mask fell. I started to pay attention to what I heard from the altar. I exposed what I was before God: that proud

The change in attitude led to a transformation. When I received the Holy Spirit, my interior was filled, and I discovered that I always had someone with me: Jesus. I was no longer alone, and I had peace within me.

God changed everything in my life. He restored my marriage, which was on the verge of divorce. Through my testimony, my husband converted and received the Holy Spirit. With the Holy Spirit, I have more than enough to live.

"Cocaine addiction took away my will to live."



James Biccas became addicted to cocaine after his first use, and this addiction almost ended his life. Through faith, he was freed and built a blessed family.

I was introduced to cocaine and cigarettes for the first time when I was 14 at a Halloween party. I got hooked from then on. It was like love at first sight; I would drop everything to snort and smoke! Cocaine was my love; I was in love with it, and for a while, it became part of my routine. But it started to hinder my social life. I could no longer socialize with people who didn't use it, and as a result, I became lonely, depressed, and had thoughts of suicide," he said.

Many young people have lost their way on the path of drugs. They start out experimenting just to please those around them, but then they find themselves trapped in addiction. This is the world's deception and the spiritual forces of evil. The drugs get their attention, and at first, it even seems good, but later, they suffer the consequences of pain and suffering.

"I remember one weekend, I started snorting on a Thursday and only stopped on Sunday. At that time, I lived alone in an apartment on the 3rd floor. All that came to my mind was, "Jump off this balcony and end it all, end this pain," because there was a huge void inside me. Although I had my parents' love and friends, I was in college and thought I lacked nothing, I didn't know God," he said.

Human beings are constantly dissatisfied. If they have money, they

lack a happy marriage; if they have a marriage, they lack children, and so on. They continue searching for total and complete fulfillment. However, there is a space inside man that only the Holy Spirit can occupy and fill. The lack of the Lord Jesus causes this void.

"My mother was attending the Universal Church and always spoke about Jesus to the family. My father eventually began going to the church, and the change started in their lives, and I noticed it. At that time, I was living in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and I decided to start attending the Universal Church. I accepted the strongest dose, God's Word; I started obeying everything said, and the great change began. I noticed after a while when I smelled cocaine and cigarettes, I felt sick to my stomach, and I started to feel disgusted. I thought, how could that have happened? One day, I was in love with cocaine, and the next, I was disgusted by it! That's what God did in my life. He gave me a stronger dose!

Today, I no longer have addictions to cigarettes or cocaine; I don't have depression or thoughts of suicide. I am free, and the Holy Spirit has filled the void! Today, I am a man who is very grateful to God and the Universal Church. I have a blessed family. I have a wonderful wife and son, and we are all God-fearing. Today, my wife and I are part of this great work that God instituted through the Universal Church. We serve Him with pleasure and great joy, and I encourage you to attend the Sunday services for a total change in your life," he concluded happily.


Shirley's life was a true spiritual battlefield. She had problems with alcoholism and felt a strange negative force violently squeezing her neck at night. Shirley almost gave up on everything, but today, she tells us where she found the strength to overcome that dark moment in her life.

"When I was a teenager, I started going to parties where everyone seemed happy with drinks in their hands. I wanted to experience that 'happiness,' so I started drinking too and began to drink a lot. Although I felt 'happy' when I was drinking and partying, as soon as I got home and put my head on the pillow, I felt a vast emptiness inside me.

I thought a relationship could fill that void, so when I met someone who seemed like my perfect partner, I decided to leave home and start a family. It was hard for my parents to see me go, but although they were very sad about it, they respected my decision. We moved in together and had a daughter. Still, unfortunately, that relationship ended after four years when he cheated on me. My dream was to have a family, so my world fell apart when I had to move back into my mother's house with my daughter.

I once again sought refuge in parties and drinking, but nothing could fill my emptiness. The anguish I felt in my heart was so great that I began to think of ways to end my life. Nightmares also plagued me. One night, I had a dream so real that I felt as if someone was literally strangling me."

I became so ill at that time that I felt I had no strength to fight for myself, but I am very grateful for my mother because she fought for me. She was a true strength!" Shirley believes that her mother's faith was a fundamental factor in ensuring that her story did not have a tragic end. "Every Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday, she was at church praying for me, and I am sure that God answered her prayers because one day, I was thinking about my



life, and I remembered that I used to attend the Universal Church with her when I was a child, and how much better my life was back then. It seemed God Himself had placed that memory in my mind, and since I could no longer bear so much suffering, I decided to go back to church. I was very well received and instructed to participate in the Chains of Prayers for a new life on Sundays at 10 AM.

I learned that to live a new and blessed life, I needed to turn my back on everything detrimental to my spiritual well-being. In my case, this included alcohol and certain friendships that did not add anything to my life. It was not easy because I was very attached to my old lifestyle. Still, I continued to attend meetings faithfully, and each session gave me the strength to stay focused until I finally overcame all my inner problems. If it were not for God, my mother's intercession, and the work of the Universal Church, I believe I would probably not be alive anymore. But fortunately, today, I am completely the opposite of who I was before. I am free from deep sadness, drinking, and all the negativity that surrounded me. Today, I am happy to be alive!"

It's not an ordinary day

Sunday is not just another day in the week; it holds a unique and significant place in our lives.

Many take it as an ordinary day since it began to be seen only as part of the weekend preceding Monday. However, there are many reasons to consider that God is present in it. Because of this, the meaning of Sunday is being lost. Many people turn to God when emergencies arise but neglect the need to put Him first before the challenges of everyday life arise. That is why Sunday exists: to hear the Voice of God before anyone else, to gather with those who also care about putting Him first, and to honor and seek Him. Sunday is a day to strengthen our spiritual life and the faith to build and establish achievements. In this sense, there is every reason to consider that God is present on this day, and we can find Him in His House. Thus, when Sunday becomes the Lord's Day, it actually becomes the "day of days" because God is there. It is a holy day to sanctify all the others.

When people dedicate the first day of the week to seeking God, they honor Him. The understanding of the first disciples was this: let us dedicate the first day of the week in allusion to the resurrection of our Lord and also in honor of Him, just as He taught us that we should, first of all, seek the Kingdom of God and, thus, all things will be added to us (read Matthew 6.33). Begin your week in the presence of God; treat the first day of the week and the first hours of that day as a moment of the Lord.

agent Dayane Lima had a childhood marked by her parents' absence, who separated when she was two. At the time, they left her with her maternal grandmother. A few years later, her mother involved another relationship, and she saw the opportunity to have a father. However, she had a sad surprise: the person her mother had been involved with tried to abuse her.



Traumatized, Dayane began to feel repulsed by men and struggle with loneliness, as she says: "I always had my grandmother and my family to give me food and material things, but I didn't even know what was

like to have affection, attention, the care of a mother and father."

At the age of 16, she arrived at the Universal Church, and, as she says, she began to understand the origin of the fear and anguish she felt when participating in the meetings: "I understood that the emptiness I had was because of the lack of the Holy Spirit."

With this understanding, she

desired to have the Presence of God and, during her prayers, asked Him to show her what she needed to do. "He showed me what I had to let go of, how to let go of my hurt towards my mother. So, she and I talked and told her I forgave her for her absence. Then, my heart felt light, and I understood the secret. I forgave, and a good feeling began inside me that I didn't have before."

That relief was just the beginning of the shift toward baptism with the Holy Spirit. Dayane says she participated in the Gathering of Faith and Miracles to eliminate the anguish. She stopped questioning why she had experienced those situations in the past, blamed herself for them, and decided to start a new life by being baptized in water.

After giving herself to Jesus, Dayane was able

to receive the Spirit of God. "I began to seek the Holy Spirit with all my strength, and then He came, and I received great joy," she recalls. She says that she heard the Voice of God: "He said to me: 'Daughter, you are no longer alone. You didn't have a father to take care of you and love you, you didn't have a mother to protect you, and you were alone your whole life, but I'm here to give you

everything you need." Upon hearing these words, she said she immediately felt peace.

Today, married and with two children, she highlights how much her life depends on the Spirit of God: "I consult Him in everything I do. The Holy Spirit teaches us to forgive, love, and look at people as He does."

Ricardo Coutinho arrived at the Universal Church in 1995. He said that when he observed his mother's transformation, who used to worship idols, he thought, "This is the God I need to serve." Soon, he embraced supernatural faith, took it seriously, and got baptized in water. He attended all services, obeyed everything he was taught based on the Word of God, and incessantly sought the Holy Spirit.

He gained his most precious asset at a night vigil: "That joy took over my heart. It was as if an eraser had passed over me, and that love came, the certainty that from that day on, my life would be completely different, and that's what happened. After the baptism with the Holy Spirit, as I was young, I focused on studies and work until I met my wife, Luciana."

Fulfilled, the couple decided it was time to have a child. But, even during pregnancy, the challenge of being a father began. In the fifth month, Luciana and Ricardo

Anna Julia was born and stayed in the neonatal ICU for 25 days. Even at home, she needed special care because she was born with severe jaundice and without the preauricular appendage. Her parents noticed that she was also not growing according to ideal standards and went to investigate the cause. With exams and biopsies, they received the diagnosis: she had a cirrhotic



liver. She needed to be placed on the transplant list.

Luciana says that when they went to church, they placed their daughter on the altar and told God to do His will. Inspired by the Holy Spirit, Ricardo searched for information about the transplant until he found a renowned hospital: "Then I discovered that

I was compatible with my daughter, and I was sure that it was the answer to our prayers. It was 12 hours of surgery, and when I woke up and went to see her, I finally met her because until then, we didn't even know her skin tone due to the jaundice."

Today, Anna Julia, aged 11, is a healthy, intelligent girl who loves being at her Father's House. Ricardo shares that he always tells his daughter she is alive not because of him who donated the liver; God deserves the glory: "It is the Holy Spirit

who has taught me to be a father who teaches his daughter about supernatural faith. We went through many struggles, but God always gave us strength and teaches me daily to educate my daughter in His Presence," he concludes.





DO YOU RELY ON LUCK TO BE SUCCESSFUL?

KNOW WHAT REALLY MATTERS TO ACHIEVE THIS GOAL

hen you look at examples of successful people, such as famous artists or actors who built brilliant careers or even great entrepreneurs who structured successful businesses, one question probably crosses your mind: Were they just lucky to succeed? Even though many people believe in luck and think it is a relevant factor in achieving outstanding achievements, achieving and maintaining success goes far beyond having it or not.

When asked if her career success was exclusively related to luck, Brazilian international supermodel Gisele Bundchen, in a recent interview with the American television network CBS, said she does not believe so. "Nothing like that. I don't think so. I believe it's because of my personality. I don't think I've ever complained. If they tell me, 'Gisele, let's do something in sub-zero temperatures or 100 degrees in Death Valley,' I go ahead and do it because I want to do my best," she explained.

WHAT DRIVES YOU?

According to her, one of the great drives of her career is always being willing to overcome challenges. "If I choose to say yes to something and if someone is putting their trust in me, I don't want to disappoint them. I am a person who strives to be the best I can be. If I set out to clean my apartment, you can eat off the floor," she said.

Some people naturally act like Gisele when they dedicate themselves to doing something, regardless of the area in which they work or want to undertake it. However, some learn to be like this and are completely successful in their activities, with businesses that only tend to grow for a very special reason: they have faith in God.

WHAT IS THE PATH?

Entrepreneur Luis Fernando Tarin, 36, is one of these examples and completely dismisses the luck factor when he talks about the success of his business in the IT department. "There is no such thing as luck or waiting for your company to succeed. You have to do something to ensure that the business always prospers. We must understand that we were made to be blessed, which involves a commitment to God. In other words, change comes from faith," he explains.

However, Luis reveals that he only had this attitude of not settling after learning about the Strong Nation service. "I received the invitation from my mother, and despite being somewhat reluctant to go to the Universal Church, this was one of the first meetings I attended, and it was essential in my life. My credit was horrible, and I was sent to collection, which caused me to feel disoriented. From the meetings, I understood how to structure my business, and it was there that I also met my wife," he says.

BEFORE AND AFTER

Before participating in the meetings, Luis worked with his father, who owned an aluminum window frame company. "My father had difficulty managing the business and had already gone bankrupt several times. So, I had the idea of creating software to help him manage the company. I bought an old computer to develop the product. It was used, but it was good. I worked from home. I also bought the same model for my brother, and he started selling our products. I told him I didn't have the money to pay but that if he sold it, he would make money," he recalls.

Today, after 15 years, Luis has a structured company with 12 employees. "The type of product I make is difficult to sell to customers who work in certain business sectors because they are unfamiliar with computers. If it weren't for the hand of God, I'm sure I wouldn't have gotten to where I am today. At the Strong Nation meeting, we learned that the heroes of
