

The life of each family depended on their obedience to this commandment...

The condition set by the Lord to save the Hebrews from the angel of death in Egypt was unconditional obedience. They had to sacrifice a lamb and spread its blood on the doorposts and lintel, roast the meat on a fire, and eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.

"And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. It is the LORD's Passover." Exodus 12.11.

The life of each family depended on their obedience to this commandment, nothing else.

Alcohol, tobacco, night outs, and pornography. It was the repertoire of Wilfried's life, who, with his wife Emmanuelle, built a marriage based on lies and infidelity.

When Wilfried and Emmanuelle started dating, he was 16, and she was 15. " Within five years of our relationship, there was no trust between us anymore; due to the many lies and infidelities, there was no prospect for the future," says Emmanuelle.

Wilfried had already known

the Universal Church in the past, in his childhood, through his mother, but he did not stray away from God as he got older. His attitude led him to a life of school failures and even to an alcoholic coma, motivated by the addiction he

developed to alcohol and being in a constant state of drunkenness. Emmanuelle, on the other hand, lived with the trauma of her parent's divorce and the fact FRUIT OF BELIEVING. that she had not had any contact with her father for many years.

RECONCILIATION

Recognition of the importance of surrendering one's life to God, reconciling with Him, and submitting to biblical guidelines led Wilfried to return to the Universal Church. Through his faith, he abandoned all addictions and became a responsible

man. This change in Wilfried made Emmanuelle attend a service for the first time.

"I decided to go to the Universal Church after observing the change in my husband. As a result, I was freed from the sadness I carried inside me, and I was able to build a relationship with whom I am currently on good terms", she declares.

"The trust between us has been completely restored, and today, we are happily married and share the same belief. We wanted to have a child at a certain point, but we couldn't. But we never gave up and, through participation in the chain of prayers, our son was born, very healthy and naturally conceived, against all expectations."

"You number my wanderings, put my tears into Your bottle" (Psalm 56:8)


God will collect our tears into His bottle, which means He does not like and does not want to see your soul crying.

"I HATED EVERYONE, ESPECIALLY MY MOTHER"



I found the Universal Church while my children were still young, and they grew up learning about the importance of God's Presence. However, as a teenager, my daughter Flavia began to listen more to her friends. Until she was 15, she was just like any other young woman, and then, she started smoking cigarettes. Before I knew it, she was already using marijuana, hookah, ecstasy, and alcohol.

Coming across the presence of drugs in the house was like seeing the dream of a united family go down the drain. The ground was shaken from under my feet. Flavia, a well-behaved child, began to distance herself and spent more time outside the house than inside. She disobeyed me and made me worried.

That was when I decided to fight for her. When she would go out and come home drunk or under the influence of drugs, we were afraid because she was very aggressive and made a series of threats. My husband and I slept with the bedroom door locked.

Flavia remembers her feelings: "I hated everyone, especially my mother, and I didn't want to be around her, so much so that I left home and went to the countryside. I spent three years without giving any news to my family because I wanted to distance myself from them."

In addition to her addictions, Flavia discovered that she had lupus, a chronic inflammatory disease of autoimmune origin (which occurs when the body itself attacks the organs and tissues). The disease affected both kidneys, and she had to undergo hemodialysis. But because of her addiction, she was not following the treatment properly nor taking her medication, to the point where her organs were no longer functional, and she was on the waiting list for a transplant.

In human eyes, Flavia's change was impossible; after all, not even the risk of losing her life made her give up the addictions. "Even so, I placed all my

trust in God. On the other hand, I also needed to change. I didn't understand that there was a spirit behind all our suffering, but when I understood that, I stopped fighting Flavia and started fighting the spirit of addiction and helping her."


In all, it took seven years of perseverance in God's promises until Flavia understood that there was no other way. "I started attending meetings and was freed from my addictions, from all my bad feelings, from my nervousness, and from everything I did wrong," says Flavia. Her mother confirmed her change today: "We couldn't be together before, but now we work together. She has a completely different behavior, and in addition to being cured of her addictions, she is cured of lupus, her kidneys are working again, and she is healthy. God made everything complete."

The family, who previously lived in fear and destruction, now has peace. "When I understood that the problem was spiritual, I saw it was a matter of life or death. I fought with all my strength, put God above all, and trusted in Him," says Deuzimar.

A happy and structured family has been a dream for many people living with the negative impacts of society's problems. For example, arguments, fights, and aggression do not solve a problem inside a person. It is because, while human strength is limited, God's power is supernatural and can turn lost cases into new lives.

Do you want to see changes in your family? You have to plant and do your part. Every Sunday, prayers are made for the family at all the branches of the Universal Church. It is a moment for you to pour out your pains, complaints, and fears so that God can come and take care of your family. Great Distribution of Anointed Oil

Holy Oil: The Divine Instrument

Every year, consecrated oil is distributed to the people for anointing. In biblical times, oil (or olive oil) was commonly used in spiritual events. For example, oil was used to keep the menorah lit in the Tabernacle built by Moses. This element could never be missing from the sacred object so that the flame would always be lit: a reference to the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Later, the disciples of the Lord Jesus used oil to promote the use of faith among people, as the apostle James writes:

"Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord" (James 5:14-15). Another reference in Mark 6:12-13 is:

"And they went out and preached that people repent. And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them."

In another biblical passage, in the book of 2 Kings 4.1-7, we saw that the oil brought prosperity to a widow in debt, who paid her debts and used the rest of the oil to care for her family. The presence of God Just as it happened in biblical times, it happens today in the lives of those who believe.


Now, with this element in hand, everyone can manifest faith to determine healing, deliverance, and protection.

FAMILIES UNDER ATTACK

life of Francislaine Gonçalves Oliveira, 45, is a story of overcoming obstacles that began with a painful childhood. Although her parents always dedicated themselves to the well-being of the family, they fought a lot, which impacted her view of relationships. "My father was a hardworking man, but unfortunately, he was an alcoholic, which resulted in difficult situations in our home, including domestic violence against my mother and constant conflict," she says. Francislaine entered the job market when she was 13 years old to seek independence and escape the constant conflicts at home. It was at this time that she met Jean Rodrigo de Oliveira with whom she developed a friendship that turned into a relationship.

Despite the differences in their lives, the couple had a good relationship at first. Jean, on the other hand, had a a baby clothes store and another for difficult adolescence due to the absence women's shoes. of his father, who abandoned the family. From an early age, he adopted harmful habits such as smoking and drinking, but he also learned from his mother the importance of work. "I was inspired by the example of my mother, who always dedicated herself intensely to work and family. So, when I met my wife, I committed to

always doing the best for her and, in the future, for our family," she says. The couple sealed their union in a church where they lived at the time. However, after the ceremony and the birth of their first daughter, the challenges increased.

"Jean was immature, wanted to live a single life, and didn't understand the responsibilities of marriage," says Francislaine. They worked a lot and Jean spent more and more time away from home because he worked in another city which contributed to the distance between them. In an attempt to solve the problem, the couple moved to that city. When they arrived there, Francislaine was already five months pregnant, expecting her second daughter. Jean opened an auto parts store, while Francislaine opened

"Although we were making progress financially, my husband spent more time with his colleagues and going to bars, which caused conflicts in our home," Francislaine explains. One morning, the couple was informed by the police that Jean's store was on fire. "Unfortunately, we lost everything



and the store was not insured. This left my husband deeply devastated." However, the worst was yet to come. The couple's oldest daughter became depressed and developed anorexia nervosa. The family sought medical help, but the situation seemed increasingly bleak. "Our life became hell, we had no money, two daughters to support and our marriage was in ruins," Francislaine recalls. During a desperate night, Francislaine discovered the Universal Church program while watching television. Inspired, she challenged her own beliefs and decided to go to church with her oldest daughter. "I attended the healing meetings in search of my daughter's recovery and I fought to save my marriage, practicing the teachings in Love Therapy.

Surprisingly, even my husband started to accompany me to church. He distanced himself from bars and negative influences. Our lives were



gradually transformed," she explains. Jean and Francislaine got married at the Universal Church. "My marriage and my family were renewed at this Altar and I will never abandon it," says Jean. "Our

family is blessed, we lack nothing and I am honored to dedicate my life to the Work of God,"concludes Francislaine.

There was a lot of frustration and unhapiness in the family.

osimeire discovered the Universal Church when she was still young. The first time she went to a meeting, she was accompanying her sister, who was seeking a cure for a health problem. Her sister got better and the whole family started attending the church. A regular attendee of the meetings, Rosimeire met Fabiano de Carvalho. She tells us how the meeting went: "He and I were members of the youth power group, we dated and got married. That's when I discovered that my faith was emotional. I discovered this because I only stayed in the church for a while before deciding to leave and I could have stayed, but I let myself get carried away. I was no longer obeying God as I should have. I started doing everything my way and was not faithful to Him."

From then on, her life began to go downhill. She became a proud person and her husband,

arrogant, because he thought he was self-sufficient. "There was great frustration, unhappiness, and insecurity within me," she explains. In addition, there were also financial complications, especially because the couple had three children to raise.

For five years, the family lived like this and it gradually fell apart. Rosimeire, who was becoming more distressed every day, suffered greatly, but her husband's situation was no better.

"We depended on my mother and motherin-law for help to eat. Sometimes they would give us money so we could go shopping or bring us food. We didn't have any suitable clothes and my mother-in-law would buy them at thrift stores," she says. The house where the family lived had leaks in the roof, because the ceilings were cracked, and it was infested with rats. They were forced to live amidst the feces of rodents and cats. For five years, the family lived like this and it gradually fell apart. Rosimeire, who was becoming more distressed every day, suffered greatly, but her husband's situation was no better. This reality only changed when they realized that all these problems

arose after they had turned away from God.



When Rosimeire and her family returned to the Universal Church, it was time for a purpose of faith. "My husband and I reached an agreement: we decided not to act according to our understanding, because doing so only brought us problems, so now we would obey the Word of God. I left the past behind and gave myself with all my strength, without reservations, alongside my husband, in the same faith. We maintained the confidence that God would change our situation," she declares. They began attending meetings to learn more about faith and obedience, but soon after participating, things got worse:

Fabiano lost his job, but this did not shake

them, because they had faith that it was just a new path that was being opened for them to follow. Shortly after, Fabiano got a new job, which was better than the previous one.

The main change in the family's life, however, was in the spiritual aspect. In place of anguish and sadness came peace and joy. Rejoicing in God, they today celebrate the happy family they built based on biblical teachings.

"Today, our lives have been transformed as a result of obedience and complete surrender on the Altar. I do not depend on my own decisions, but I am guided by the Holy Spirit, who always inspires and directs me. My family lives the fullness of God's wonders," she concludes.

You are not Alone!

"From a 12yr Sentence, to a 30yr Sentence."

My name is Osvaldo. I'm 51 years old. Between the ages of 13-14, I got involved with drugs. I was using crack, cocaine, and heroin drugs that opened the door to destruction in my life.

I became a person who would steal and commit assaults and robberies. I found myself as an addict. But there was another side to the drugs. I realized I could also gain money from this, so I got into drug trafficking. Police were looking for me constantly; I got involved in a lot of craziness, one of them being a homicide.



The police came to my home and circled me in; I had nowhere to run to, and then I got arrested and went to prison. I remember that place being so dark, cold, and dangerous.



The only good thing there was getting to know the UBB. The volunteers there would try to

get close and talk to me so they could help me.

They invited me to join the services, but I resisted for a while. But there was always a voice of guilt, "Oh, you killed someone, now you want to go to church? What will they think of you?"

But I knew I was suffering.

So, one day, I resolved that issue and went to UBB service, and I felt good. The pastor called for baptism for those who wanted to leave the old life behind.

I chose to get baptized right away in the prison. I got rid of the hidden cell phone I had; I told those who were on the street selling drugs to me to stop.

I didn't want anything to do with that life anymore. The night before, I remember, funnye nough, having a dream so peaceful that it felt like I was in heaven.

The following Wednesday, they had the service of the Holy Spirit, and I gave my all, complete surrender; the room was full of inmates.



It was fantastic. The seeking was amazing; it was so strong. That day was like floating; I didn't remember that I was in jail and didn't care about where I was. It was me and God. I didn't care

about the sentencing I had for 30 years. I was in heaven. I had peace, joy, and power. I said, "My god, why didn't I know this life before?"

My thoughts changed; my words changed. I was freed from prison while in prison. I was another eight years after I received the Holy Spirit. I was so light and free! I started to serve God behind bars; during the time I was there, I experienced a process of strength, change, and growth.

I told God to let his will be done in me. When I was told I was going home, I felt sad because I knew I would no longer see those I was with; I would miss the guards, officers, etc. Because of my change, I became friends with everyone. But before I left, I prayed with the officials and the inmates; they accepted my prayer.

I felt worthy in that moment. I was once a murderer and criminal, but God showed me I was worthy through Him. It brings tears to my eyes, even when I think about where God took me from. Today, I am a business owner. I thank God for the UBB; through them, I found Him, and my life is completely transformed. If you asked me what my greatest dream is, I would say to make it to heaven.

There is no motivation here for me on this earth but to be in the arms of my Jesus.

What problem is consuming your family?

owadays, the word 'family' carries no weight. Home is supposed to be a haven—a place of comfort and support. Still, home is a battleground for many because families are upside down or falling apart.

Fights: Perhaps your family members are constantly bickering over everything.

Addictions: Addiction is never a 'one person' problem; everybody is affected.

Disease: The pain of watching a loved one in pain can be unbearable.

Maybe these problems are taking a toll on you, and you feel desperate because you are losing your family one by one.

In the Gospel of Luke 7:13, Jesus said, "Do not weep". He was speaking to a woman who had lost her husband and then lost her son as well.


She had lost her entire family and was alone.

"Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." Luke 7:14

FROM BEGGAR TO BUSINESMAN



e lost his father in adolescence, and his mother had to raise him and his eight brothers alone, with her only income coming from working in the fields.

At the age of 16, Silvano got a girl pregnant, and her parents wanted to force them to marry. When he refused, her father tried to kill him.

Her mother stopped him by saying: "don't kill him because what I have for him is much worse than death: he will become a beggar, he will eat garbage

." Later, he got his first job at a restaurant. Silvano got promoted to be in charge of the place. Still, he reports: "I started getting involved with the wrong people,

drinking, and late-night partying. I would leave work and go party until, because of addictions, I got fired."

Soon, due to his addiction, Silvano began to live on the streets. "I became a beggar and started eating garbage. It was the hardest time I ever went through," he recalls.

One morning, he remembered the curse that that woman had placed on him. Silvano received an invitation to the Universal Church. "I already received help there and then because I felt light; I saw a new way to start my life because that weight had already left me. The pastor gave me the Word that is much more than a plate of food."

Silvanus decided to live according to the Word of God. He abandoned addictions, and the mark of his change was when he received the Presence

of God. Sometime later, Silvano met his wife. Initially, they sold snacks door-to-door, but later they rented a small space. Today they have a pizzeria and a restaurant. "I was homeless, a nobody; I never imagined having what God has given me. The most precious possession I have is the Holy Spirit.

I always say in my prayers that with Jesus I can go back to the street, but without Him, I don't want to live in palaces", he concludes.
