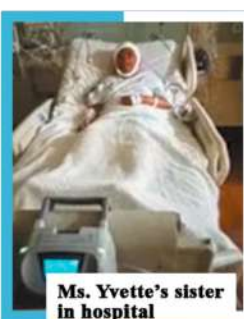

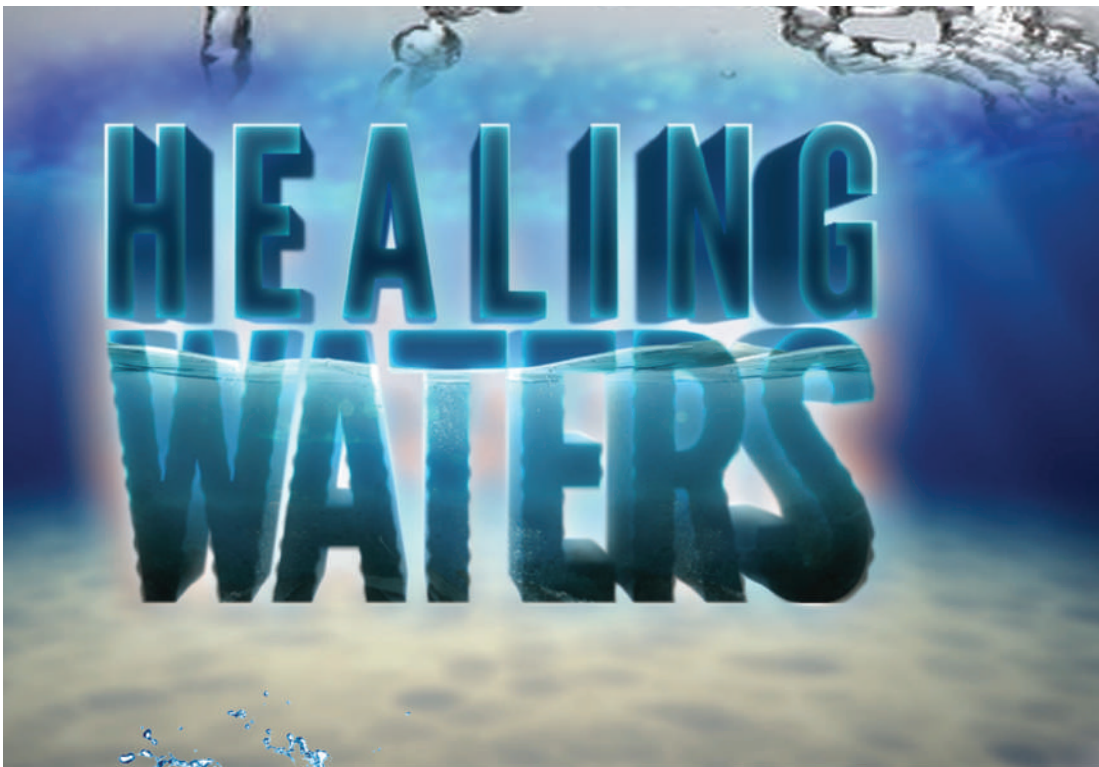

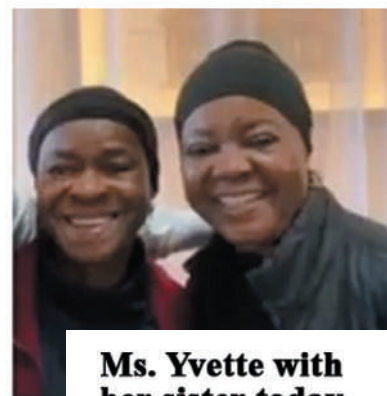

WHY THE WATER?



Perhaps you've attended a Universal Church service or seen us on TV and wondered: Why do we use Blessed Water or other holy elements during the services? If you look into the Bible, water has consistently been a tool through which miracles were performed.

For example, the first miracle Jesus performed involved water—He turned water into wine. As it is written:

Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim. And He said to them, "Draw some out now..." (John 2:7-8)

In this first recorded miracle of Jesus, water was used as a tool to reveal God's power. This pattern is seen throughout Scripture: Naaman was healed of leprosy when he obeyed the prophet's instruction to wash in the Jordan River; a blind man received his sight after washing in the Pool of Siloam. These examples show that God often uses physical elements as instruments to stir faith and bring about His miracles.

It's the same for you today. When you use the water—or any element that has been blessed—by faith, it becomes a tool in God's hands to perform a miracle in your life. It's not the element itself that holds power, but your faith in God working through it.

Think of it this way: just as a mechanic uses tools to repair a car, God uses holy elements as tools to transform and bless lives. The next time you are in a service and receive the Blessed Water or another sacred element, use it with faith. Trust not in the element but in God, who uses it to work wonders.

May the God of the Bible bless you!

My Miracle from the Well

Because of allergies, I developed eczema that covered my body with painful sores. It was unbearable—I couldn't sleep, bathe, or even sit comfortably. Clothes would stick to my skin because of the sores, so I often had to wear light clothing or none at all.



When I visited the doctor, I was prescribed different medications, but none of them worked. I was then given steroids and had to take an injection every two weeks. After the first dose, I felt some relief, but after the second dose, I had a severe allergic reaction. When I called the doctor, I was told to stop the treatment immediately.

The sores caused a constant heat radiating from my body, and I couldn't leave the house because the heat would aggravate the pain. Ice packs became my only relief, and when I ran out, my daughter used frozen meat packs to help me cope. My life was a torment—I had to stop working, and I felt completely trapped by my condition.

When I received the Blessed Water, I warmed it and used it to sprinkle over my body in the shower. I also drank it with faith, believing in God's power to heal me. Little by little, the sores began to dry up. Today, they are completely gone, leaving only the marks as a testimony to the miracle God performed in my life.

This was not magic—it was a miracle, proving that what God did in the past, He still does today. WHAT IS ECZEMA?

Eczema (eg-zuh-MUH) is the name for a group of inflammatory skin conditions that cause itchiness, dry skin, rashes, scaly patches, blisters and skin infections. There are seven different types of eczema: atopic dermatitis, contact dermatitis, dyshidrotic eczema, nummular eczema, seborrheic dermatitis and stasis dermatitis. For lighter skin, eczema can present as red, inflamed skin. For darker skin tones, eczema can present as brown, purple, gray or ashen. Itchy skin is the most common symptom of eczema.

" I was healed from Thyroid Cancer "



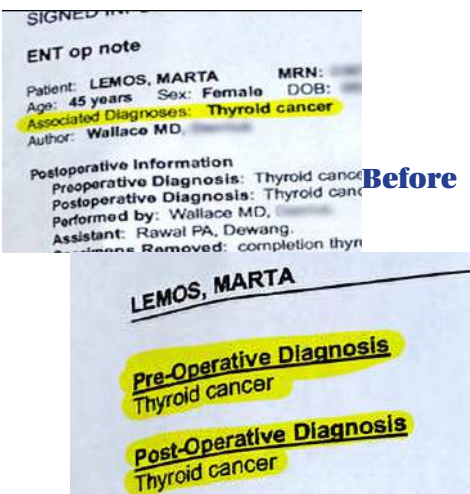

Today, I'm healed. I feel strong. I have no more pain, and I no longer need the walker. I don't need to take any medication anymore. God restored my health completely.

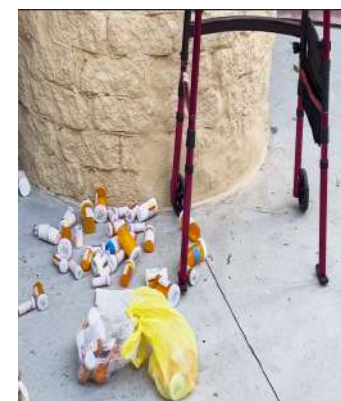

The doctors diagnosed me with high cholesterol, cardiac arrhythmia, high blood pressure, and panic attacks. I struggled with panic attacks for ten years.

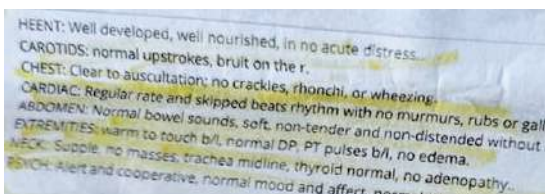
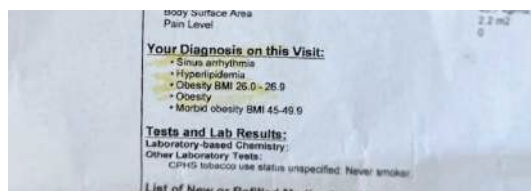

Enticed by the world

My mom found the Universal Church when I was young, and we attended regularly. I was active in the youth group, firm in my involvement. But I was immature, and as time passed, I became enticed by the world. I got involved in crime, fell into addiction, and lived a life centered on drinking, smoking, money, and women.



The first time I went to prison, I served two years. When I got out, I tried to live a “normal”



life—I got a job and maintained that lifestyle for three years. However, I eventually returned to crime, worse than before. My actions escalated to committing assaults, robberies, carrying guns, and street fights. This cycle led me back to prison, where I experienced a near-death moment.

But in that moment, God saved me. While incarcerated, I encountered the Universal Beyond Bars (UBB) ministry. I began attending their



services and making prayers of faith, seeking God’s help for my physical freedom. According to my sentence, I was supposed to remain in prison until December 2024, but God made a way, and I was released in May 2024.

However, I left prison with the same mindset as before—frustrated and hopeless. I had nothing. I depended on my mom for even the smallest things, like a haircut. Thoughts of returning to crime began to consume me: “I need money. I need to rob something. I’m 30 years old and still depending on my mother.”

During this time, my mom invited me to return to the Universal Church. I was hesitant, but I decided to go. At one service, I heard a word that deeply touched me. The pastor said that God didn’t care about my past and would accept me as I was. I prayed, telling God:

“If You accept me as I am, do something in my life so I don’t return to the lifestyle I lived before.” That prayer marked a turning point. As I shifted my mind from crime to trusting in God, I began to see Him working in my life.



I committed to attending Sunday services and later added the Wednesday services as well. I made the decision to get baptized in water, understanding

that transformation requires action on our part. I realized that God doesn’t delay acting in our lives—it’s often us who delay our transformation.

With this in mind, I sought the Holy Spirit with alertness, consciousness, and care. And on December 22, 2024, I received the Holy Spirit. It was the greatest day of my life.

He was despised by everyone, but when he emptied himself, he immediately became a son of Abraham. And consider Paul—who persecuted Christians.

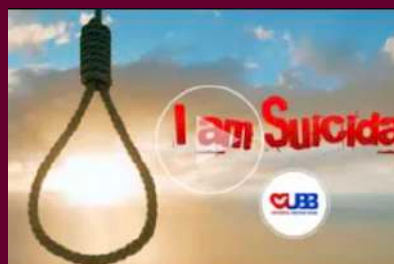


But just three days after being confronted by Jesus, he was filled with the Holy Spirit.

A SUCCESSFUL BUSINESSMAN ON THE RISE.

Anyone who sees Edevaldo Ferreira cannot imagine his path to enjoying a luxurious life. He was born into a humble family. Limitations and difficulties marked his life growing up. He dreamed of a different reality, but his attempts became frustrated. In search of a better future, he moved to a different state. Still, new opportunities did not arise, and after a year away from home and without a job, he returned to his parent's house. He started working as his brother's employee and lived an average life for years.

He came across the Universal church programming on TV, and the testimonies caught his attention. "I wanted a change in my life. I no longer accepted my life that way. MONEY TIPS THAT GROW WITH YOUR CHILDREN

The following tips are organized by age level, but use your best judgment when it comes to your child's maturity level before permitting him or her to explore the following milestones on their own. It's also imperative that you demonstrate these skills to your children at home before they practice them in the real world. Once your child takes charge of his or her own checking account, investments, or any type of credit, keep the lines of communication open to prevent major mishaps.

- Young Children: Building the Foundation**
 - Learning the basic concepts of good spending and saving habits is ideal for children beginning around age five.**
 - Shopping Sense:** Take your child to the grocery store and show him or her the cost of different items. Have your child use a calculator to help you find the best values while shopping.
 - Piggy Bank:** Give your child coins and bills to put in her piggy bank to purchase small items and learn about saving.
 - Wants vs. Needs:** Discuss the things that you'd like to have vs. the things that you need to live.
 - Compare Prices:** Use currency or other items representing value to demonstrate the cost of items at the store. Show your child that some toys or other items cost more than others. Talk about the difference in price between different toys or items your child might want.
 - Generosity:** This is a good age to teach your child about giving. Have them select an item of theirs they no longer use to give to charity. Have them choose food items from your pantry to donate to a food bank.
- Young Children to Tweens: Budgeting Basics**
 - Allowances:** Giving your child a certain amount of money to budget helps them develop responsible money management skills. Although parents have various views on allowances, such as if the amount is conditional on work or chores completed, it is up to you to decide what works best for your family.
 - Making Change:** Children at this stage should learn the value of different denominations of currency and how to make change.
 - Short and Long-Term Goals:** Encourage your child to set short and long-term savings goals such as her weekly entertainment budget, and how much she plans to put aside for more costly items.
 - Easy Economics:** This is a good age to introduce developmentally appropriate concepts of home and our nation's economy.
 - Save Early:** Children are usually too young for checking accounts at this age, but they may be ready for a savings account. If not, you can reevaluate in a few years.
- Tweens to Teens: Training Wheels**
 - Checking Accounts:** This is a good time to teach your child about borrowing, saving, and how credit cards work. Prepare Johnny for his own checking account by showing him how to write a check, use the register, and monitor the balance online.
 - Odd Jobs:** Kids this age may enjoy earning extra money by mowing lawns, gardening, or babysitting, for example.
 - Young Entrepreneur:** Basic business concepts are an excellent topic for some children. If you have a child with ample motivation and interest in business, you may invest in resources to teach your little tycoon basic entrepreneurship skills.
 - Teens Almost There:** Teens should know or be in the process of learning the financial skills necessary for credit and investing in topics they should have a handle on before doing so.
 - Investing in the Future:** The teen years often present the best opportunity to learn about the basics of investing such as retirement accounts, CDs, stocks, and more. For the responsible, investment-savvy teen, you may allow them to invest small sums (that you don't mind losing) in stocks and have them track the results. (And keep careful records for tax purposes.)
 - More About Credit Cards:** Junior may be ready to learn more about how to responsibly use credit. Consider a prepaid debit card, co-signing a new card or adding your teen to your existing credit card.
 - Big Plans:** Learning how to plan for purchases such as cars, homes, and college tuition helps your teen easily transition into adulthood.
 - Jobs:** Part-time jobs, odd jobs, or even a business for that young tycoon, may help foster responsible money and business management skills.
