# Faith without anything to lose

ig or small, it doesn't matter-supernatural faith is a gift from the Holy Spirit, the power of God within those who are poor in spirit (Matthew 5:3). When it comes to faith, there is no "more or less." Either a person has it, or they don't.

Because faith is a gift from God, it is personal and cannot be forced on anyone. Jesus spoke in parables so that those with hardened hearts—the proud and the hypocrites, like the chief priests and Phariseeswould not understand (Mark 4:11, Luke 8:10). This confirms that supernatural faith is not for everyone (Isaiah 53:1).

But for those who have received it, faith is the power of God within them. Its size doesn't matter. Just like a grain of sand inside an oyster transforms into a pearl of great value, the faith that comes from God is placed in the hearts of the humble, ready to grow and make the impossible possible.

# "I no longer have the lump in my breast"



usinessman Duarte, 60, grew up in a dysfunctional home filled with fights. As the son of a drug-addicted, drug-dealing father, he witnessed constant conflict caused by his father's addiction. One of the most unforgettable moments of his childhood was watching his father get arrested.

Duarte says he was introduced to the world of crime at an early age, leading to a life of being in and out of prison. During his teenage years, he and his brother became involved in drug trafficking.

Hoping to change their situation, his mother moved to a different city for a fresh start, but things only got worse. Duarte was arrested again and spent his 18th birthday in prison. After his release, he returned to his ĥometown, only to be arrested once more. This time, when he got out, he went to his mother's house. Desperate, she sought help from various religions but found no solutions.

"I made a pact with the devil," Duarte confesses. "I told him, 'If you give me all the drugs I want, I'll give you my life."

Tired of suffering, his mother eventually threw him out. He vividly remembers that moment: "I was lost and had no idea what to do. With nowhere to go, I ended up in a rough neighborhood, where drug traffickers took me in." That "adoption" only pushed him further

into addiction. "I used everything—cigarettes, alcohol, marijuana, cocaine, 'perfume,' and crack—so much that even the drug dealers wanted to kill me because I was turning into a 'junkie.' My mother used to say, 'A crooked tree is born crooked and will die crooked,"

Sometime later, Duarte started working, got married, and had two children. He tried to live a better life, but his addictions eventually destroyed everything. He lost his family, his job, and everything he had worked for. His wife cheated on him and abandoned him. He hit rock bottom when he nearly died—except someone else took the bullet meant for him. "I saw a 14-year-old boy die in my place because the bullet was meant for me but hit him instead. His death gave me the chance to escape," Duarte says.

He fled aimlessly and wandered for about 15 days, lost and confused. That was when he came across a Universal Church—one he had passed many times before without noticing. A volunteer invited him to join a deliverance service happening at that moment. "At first, I

didn't want to go, but the assistant insisted. I felt so burdened and heavy that I actually felt sick. During the prayer, an evil spirit manifested, saying it was in my life because of the hatred I had for the mother of my children after she betrayed and left me," he reveals.

The pastor spoke to him about forgiveness. At first, Duarte didn't want to forgive, but the pastor explained that it was an exchange with God—he had to forgive in order to free himself and receive the Holy Spirit.

When he finally understood the power of forgiveness, he sought out his ex-wife. "When I saw her, I asked for forgiveness. In the world of crime, there is no such thing as forgiveness—asking for it is humiliating. But I didn't feel humiliated; I knew I was doing the right thing. When I left, a joy took hold of me," he explains.

After that, Duarte returned to the Universal Church, got baptized, and began his jour-

> ney of faith. He actively sought the Holy Spirit, and when he received Him, everything changed. "An overwhelming joy filled me—something I had never felt before. It gave me a certainty I had never known. I left wanting to tell everyone what I was experiencing," he says.

Within a year, Duarte was free from addiction, baptized, and filled with the Holy Spirit. He reflects on his past life: "I

had no desire to live. My life revolved around drugs. I didn't enjoy anything. Sometimes, I would speed up in front of trucks as a 'joke,' but deep down, I wanted to die—I couldn't stand the emptiness. My friends even called me 'The Devil's Son.' But when God gave me the chance to change, I saw the difference between good and evil, and I surrendered. I had never known a love as great as God's. My own mother, the one I thought loved me, threw me out. But God accepted me as I was."

He realized that only the Holy Spirit could bring him the peace and joy he had always sought. "The Holy Spirit is my reason for living. We are here, but there's a better place. He teaches me how to live in this world and be a light in the darkness," he says.

After overcoming trauma, addiction, crime, and two divorces, he built a family rooted in God's teachings. "The joy the Holy Spirit gives can't be bought. It's a peace that stays, even when life is tough. Only those who have the Holy Spirit truly understand," he concludes

"I was diagnosed with leukemia and had to undergo chemotherapy. The disease caused constant nosebleeds that sometimes lasted for hours. I lost so much blood at one point that only water came out. At my weakest, I weighed just 61 pounds. My hair was falling out, I had no appetite, and my nails became thin and brittle.

The treatment wasn't working. The specialists had given up on me—there was nothing more they could do. But what was impossible for them, God made possible.

Someone invited me to the Universal Church, telling me I could find help there. I started going regularly. One day, I prayed, 'Lord, if You exist, help me—I want to be healed.' I surrendered my life on the Altar, and by persevering in faith, God began to help me. I started eating and sleeping well, and little by little, my health improved.

By using my faith and the tools God gave me, my life was transformed. My health was restored—I beat cancer. My relationship with my daughters also improved. God freed me from the hatred I had carried for years and even blessed my finances.

The pages of the Holy Book are filled with reliable accounts describing countless miracles like this. However, when we close the Bible, these miracles have not stopped. They continue to happen successively, through sincere, practical and bold faith. "God is a God who heals. He did this in the past, does it today and will always do so, because He does not change."

Miracles produced through faith arise in the face of problems, including those related to the healing of illnesses. Intelligent faith recognizes the role of medicine, which is inspired by God to heal, save, and create vaccines and treatments, but medicine also has limits and it is at the limit of medicine that the power of faith begins. "Just as intelligent faith recognizes the role of medicine, intelligent medicine also recognizes the role of faith, because without faith the patient does not even take the medicine and the treatment does not work properly if he does not believe." This means that a miracle does not dispense with the attitude of the human being, that is, a convinced action that represents belief and trust in God through the practice of intelligent faith.

Whatever the miracle, the common denominator among them is this faith expressed in God, through the Name of the Lord Jesus, which makes possible what was considered impossible. Only He has the power to accept the rejected, heal the incurable, and transform lost cases into testimonies.

onathan Oliveira dos Santos is the youngest of four children. His parents are Janet Sena de Oliveira and Marcos Ludelton Oliveira dos Santos. Janet remembers well the day when she asked her son, who was 16 then, to go to the supermarket near her home to buy an ingredient that was missing for dinner.

"He always went to places near our house by bike and rode along the sidewalk, but that day I noticed that he took longer to return. I went to the balcony of the building and saw some movement on the avenue and, when

motorcycle", says Janete. In the accident, Jonathan hit his head hard on the ground and immediately went into a coma. He was taken to the hospital, intubated, and had a severe head injury. Doctors gave him only a 5% chance of survival. He underwent surgery that lasted eight hours.

The family was already familiar with the faith and had been seeking God for years at the Universal Church. "We came together in prayer. After 48 hours of surgery, in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), the clinical prediction was

brain death, because in the accident he had lost brain mass. That was when our fight began," says Janete.

After two months in a coma, Jonathan opened his eyes and was transferred to a hospital room, but the diagnosis

was that he would be in a vegetative state. He lost a lot of weight and now weighed only 66 lbs. For many, the only alternative would be to quit and accept that situation, but his family saw that moment as a moment to achieve a miracle.

In addition to that condition, Jonathan contracted a hospital infection and had to be transferred to another hospital. "He was very weak and, in addition to the risk of dying from the trauma, there was also the infection. The family took turns at the hospital," says Janete.

The parents say that, in addition to the medical treatment, spiritual treatment was also carried out. Janet details what was done: "Whoever stayed with him in the hospital brought consecrated water to bathe him. We anointed his clothes and made vows at the Altar. We obeyed the direction of faith that God gave us. It was a period of great struggle, pain, and faith. It was our baptism with fire."

Marcos reports "I told God that, if Jonathan were to live, it would be to bear witness to the name of the Lord. God placed in me a great certainty



that my son would be cured. We set out for total faith at the Altar of the Lord in a purpose of faith and when we came down from the Altar once again, the certainty of his cure was testified to."

Jonathan surprised the medical team day after day. His brain regenerated and he underwent surgery to place a cranial prosthesis. He was able to eat, walk, and talk again. He was discharged from the hospital after a year and

that my son would be cured. We set out for two months of hospitalization and underwent total faith at the Altar of the Lord in a purpose physiotherapy and speech therapy sessions.

Although he does not remember the accident, he recognizes that his life is a miracle. He completed his studies and led a normal life. Alongside his parents, he continues to seek God and maintain his physical and spiritual health at the Universal Church. "I am doing very well, thank God. What He did in my life was glorious," Jonathan concludes.

# "I got to know the world and deceitful relationships."

essica Brito is an only child. She "grew up in a happy family" and was "well raised", as she says. This welcoming environment, however, shared space with the dangerous and violent neighborhood where she lived. "I got to know the world and deceitful relationships and started hanging out with bad company", she recalls. At 18, she got involved with drugs and, consequently, other doors opened for her.

So, she started going to clubs in the outskirts, met people from drug trafficking, made easy money and started carrying large-caliber weapons.

Jessica spent her nights on the streets. "I lived

more outside than at home. My son, now 3 years old, became my parents' son." She tells how her addiction affected her at home: "My father would say that I was different, too skinny and bossy. It was the effect of the drugs. I lost the bond I used to have with him, I would scream and not know how to talk.



But my mother, who was nervous, changed her attitude and started praying. I remember seeing her with the bedroom door closed, asking God for strength." She remembers that her mother, Rosária, was already attending the Universal Church at the time.

After a night of partying and drug addiction, she realized she needed help. When she recognized herself as a drug addict, she decided to go to the hospital. "I used marijuana and ecstasy. Cocaine was also ruining my life. I went to my mother to ask for help." Her mother's reaction was to give me words of life and faith. Jessica repeats what she heard from her: "I'm not going to put you in a hospital. I'm going to take you to the Universal Church. There, my God will take care of you and I am sure that your change begins now."

Jessica took a long time to go. Until one fine day, as she says, she went alone. "I was sure that this would be my last door and only way out." At the first meeting, she realized that she was free from oppression and inner emptiness. Now, she says that her history of aggression, fights and rebellion is behind her. "I was a troublemaker, disturbed and independent, because I received easy money that gave me a life without material needs. But I lacked what I have today: peace, self-love, character, love, kindness and grace," she says.

She tells the secret that transformed her: "I received the Holy Spirit. I feel within me a strength capable of withstanding anything. God guides and sustains me."

My mother's addiction to cigarettes and alcohol led me down the same path. I worked hard, but during my breaks, I drank excessively to cope.

I surrounded myself with friends who used drugs and smoked, and eventually, I started doing the same. I also got involved with multiple women. After using drugs and hallucinogens, I started hearing voices, but I refused to change.

Things only got worse. At one point, I tried to take my own life by drinking rat poison, but a family member found out in time. I was diagnosed with depression and bipolar disorder, and the doctors told me there was no cure. When I got home, I went right back to my old ways—I took all the drugs I had, drank heavily, and started planning a robbery to get more.

After the robbery, I was sent to prison. While there, I saw people praying and came across the Universal Church (UBB). The pastor's message spoke to me, and for the first time, I started building my faith. I no longer wanted to end my life, and the voices stopped.

But when I got out, I lost my way again. I thought marriage and fatherhood would help me escape drugs, but they didn't.

hard. My wife and I struggled to put food on the table for ourselves and our daughter. The drugs only made things worse, feeding the dark voices in my head. They whispered: "Kill your wife, your daughter, and then yourself."

One night, high on cocaine, I found myself watching a Universal Church program. The man of God spoke with conviction, sharing a Bible verse that struck me. I understood the message and decided to attend the church.

No one judged me there. I confessed everything. And when I walked out of that service, I made up my mind—I was going to do my part, not just for God, but for myself.

That Friday, the temptation to use drugs and smoke was overwhelming, but I fought it and said, "No." I kept attending church, and one day, I heard the pastor talk about the Holy Spirit—how necessary He is.

That message changed everything. I surrendered my life, and God delivered me. I was baptized with the Holy Spirit.

"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."" Matthew 11:28-30

From that moment on, I was different. I placed my life on the altar, and God poured His love and One day, the weight of my miserable life hit me grace over me. He removed my pride, my bad

character—everything that had held me back.

People who once knew me couldn't believe my transformation. Now, I have compassion for others. I share God's word with those who are suffering—the lost youth, the broken families, the ones who feel like there's no way out.






















# **REAP PROSPERITY TODAY**



wo years ago, businesswoman Andreia, 43, faced one of the darkest periods of her life. She battled persistent health issues, including severe bleeding that led to anemia.
