A symbol of God's presence

In the Holy Scriptures, olive oil is widely used for healing, deliverance, and consecration, representing the Holy Spirit.

The Bible is full of symbolism, and through it we understand important truths about faith. One of the best-known examples is olive oil. In the Scriptures, it represents the Holy Spirit, that is, the presence of God. Its use was common in biblical times, and we find it throughout both the Old and New Testaments.

The clear oil extracted from olives was used in the Tabernacle built by Moses to keep the lamps burning, representing God's presence in our lives. It was also used to consecrate priests, such as Aaron, as recorded in Leviticus 8:10 to 12, and to anoint kings, as in the case of David. In fact, when David was anointed, the Spirit of the Lord came upon him from that moment on, as written in 1 Samuel 16:13.

A point of contact for faith

When the Lord Jesus sent out His disciples to preach the Gospel, they used oil as a point of contact to stir faith, and many miracles took place. The Bible says, "So they went out and preached that people should repent. They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them" (Mark 6:12 to 13).

Later, the apostle James also gave this instruction: "Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven" (James 5:14 to 15).

Because of all these spiritual references, consecrated oil is still used today not only for anointing in cases of illness, but also as a point of contact for faith in spiritual deliverance, for receiving the Holy Spirit, for overcoming situations that seem impossible, for protection, and for consecrating people and their belongings to God.

For this reason, once a year, in all Universal Churches, a portion of consecrated oil is given free of charge. This year, the day set aside for the distribution of the Sacred Anointing Oil is April 5, Easter Sunday.

Repellent against evil

"You anoint my head with oil..." Psalm 23:5

What David said in this verse stands out. Before becoming king, David was a shepherd, so he understood how to care for sheep.

In those days, shepherds had to protect their sheep in harsh, dry environments where insects and flies constantly attacked them. These insects would often target the moisture in the sheep's nostrils to lay their eggs, which would quickly turn into larvae. When that happened, the sheep became desperate. They would run back and forth, shaking their heads, trying to escape the irritation.

This condition would leave the sheep weak and distressed. Some would even slam their heads against rocks or trees in an attempt to relieve the discomfort.

To protect them, shepherds would anoint the sheep's heads with oil. The oil acted as a repellent, keeping the insects away and bringing relief.

In the same way, the devil tries to attack the mind. He wants to plant harmful thoughts, create confusion, and lead a person into discouragement, fear, and despair. Today, many people



struggle with overwhelming thoughts that leave them feeling defeated and hopeless. Some even reach the point of wanting to end their lives because they lack spiritual protection.

This oil does not refer only to a physical substance. It points to the presence of the Holy Spirit and the experience of a transformed life. When a person receives the Holy Spirit, they receive protection. Evil may try to come against them, but it cannot remain, because there is a spiritual defense in place.

"But the one who is born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him." 1 John 5:18



Doctors found a blood clot in his brain

The consecrated oil should be part of daily life, not only for personal use, but also to help those close to you who need God's intervention. That is what

happened in the life of administrative analyst Wesley, now 27 years old.

At 18, even though he had always been healthy, he received a serious diagnosis. Doctors found a blood clot in his brain that needed immediate surgery. The procedure carried significant risk because the doctors did not know exactly what they would find when operating on such a sensitive area.

Just moments before the surgery, his father told him

that he would anoint his head with the consecrated oil and that he would be healed.

"At that moment, I felt peace as I went into surgery, and I believed in that prayer," Wesley recalls.

"Thank God, the clot was above the brain, and I had no complications. I came out of surgery awake and talking. The doctors could not even give a recovery timeline, yet I spent less than three days in the intensive care unit. On the seventh day, I was discharged and able to go back home. I believe God acted at the moment of the anointing and prayer, and everything that could have gone wrong was turned around."



A miracle through faith

Cristina, a 63-year-old nursing technician, used the consecrated oil as she sought a miracle for her own life.

In 2016, doctors diagnosed her with a malignant tumor in her thyroid. At that moment, she chose to put her faith into action and believe for a different outcome.

"After I received the diagnosis, I refused to accept that disease in my body. I already knew the Word of God, so I started using my faith. I took part in the

chains of prayer and anointed the affected area with the oil," she explains.

When the day of the surgery came, something unexpected happened.

"The doctors began the procedure, but when they opened the area, they found nothing. The tumor was gone. The Lord Jesus had already healed me," she says with joy.

Igor, 23, a nursing student, lived with a tumor in his throat for three years. It started as a small lump on his neck when he was 14, but since it did not cause any pain, he ignored it. Over time, it grew to 12 centimeters, affecting his health, self-esteem, and social life. He faced bullying and eventually could not eat or sleep properly because the tumor was blocking his throat.

After years of searching for answers and receiving different diagnoses, tests finally confirmed that it was a malignant tumor, and he needed urgent surgery. “It was going to be a very delicate procedure. There was a risk of lasting complications. But I used my faith through campaigns, prayer chains, and even the use of blessed water, trusting that everything would go well,” he recalls. The surgery was successful, and the tumor was completely removed.

The results

After follow up care, Igor made a full recovery with no signs of the disease and no lasting effects. Today, he lives a normal life, is in good health, and is preparing to work in the healthcare field. He believes this experience strengthened his faith. Now, he shares his testimony, saying he trusts in God and lives as if he never had the problem, using his story to inspire others.

“My eyes are much better now”



I used to struggle with dry eyes all the time, and it caused me a lot of discomfort. I had to use medication in my eyes every day.

I started using the blessed water first, and then I would apply the medicine. Over time, my eyes began to improve. Today, they are much better. Another situation I faced involved my son. He

made some bad decisions that caused problems in our family for about five years. During that time, he would not talk to me or even greet me. At family gatherings like Thanksgiving, he would greet everyone except me.

Even so, I did not give up on my faith.

One Sunday, right after Mother’s Day, I was at church. When the service ended and I walked outside, my son was there waiting for me to take me home.

God gave me my son back. Today, our relationship is restored, and we are doing very well.— Silvia



“I had high blood pressure and diabetes”

My blood pressure used to be very high, and I was constantly sick. I felt nauseous, weak, and had no strength in my body. I felt helpless. Whenever I went to work, I could not keep up. There were times when my boss had to call my daughter to pick me up because I could not continue. I was taking three pills for high blood pressure and three for diabetes.

I started using the blessed water every day, praying in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. At my last doctor’s visit, my results showed that my blood pressure had dropped to 109 over 57.

Today, I can work normally and have no issues.

I overcame depression through faith

My name is Maria Martyr, and I want to share my testimony with you. I struggled with deep depression, but today I can say that I overcame it.

When I first came to church, I was extremely depressed. I was what people call a functional person with depression. I had a family, I worked, and I took care of my two

daughters. But when they went to sleep, I would cry myself to sleep. On weekends, when my daughters stayed with other family members, I would spend the whole day in bed, crying, restless, and unable to find peace.

I could not sleep properly. I had lost both of my parents within a few years, and that pain made my depression even worse. Every day I went to work, smiled at people, and acted like everything was fine. No one knew the pain I carried inside. My heart felt completely broken. I used to say it was shattered into pieces, and nothing could ever put it back together.

When I came to church, I began to learn that the heart can be restored. I learned about prayer, about faith, and about the anointing oil. I learned how to use it and how to apply my faith in God, believing that He is alive and able to heal.

At the beginning, all I did was cry. Every service, I cried deeply. But as I continued learning about God and practicing my faith, I started using the anointing oil. I anointed my head, my heart, my body, even my mouth, asking God every day to heal me from depression and negative thoughts. I had even struggled with suicidal thoughts, so I cried out to Him daily to restore my heart.



The oil everyone needs and can receive. Understand the importance of this element that will be distributed on Sunday, April 5, at every Universal Church. On Easter Sunday, April 5, the consecrated oil from the Garden of Gethsemane in the Holy Land will be distributed at every Universal Church. This purpose happens only once a year, which makes this free distribution even more meaningful.

The spiritual meaning of the oil is well known. One of its most important meanings is that it represents the Holy Spirit. Since He is essential in our lives, the anointing with consecrated oil represents His guidance, not only in difficult moments, but every day.

The oil carries qualities that help strengthen and awaken a person's faith. It was widely used in biblical times, and using it today reminds us of its importance. In the Tabernacle built during the time of Moses, the oil was used to keep the Menorah, the seven branched lampstand, burning. In the same way, our spiritual life depends on keeping the presence of God's Spirit alive within us.

In Exodus 30:22 to 33, the Bible describes the holy anointing oil. In Exodus 40:9, it shows that the oil was used to consecrate sacred items. In Leviticus 14:10 to 18, it was used for the purification of those who were sick. It was also used to anoint kings and priests, such as Saul and David.

In the New Testament, the Lord Jesus instructed His disciples to use oil for healing and deliverance, as written in Mark 6:13. In James 5:14 and 15, it says, "Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord."

Cancer was hidden in her for seven years

When Kethlyn Ortiz discovered the disease, her condition was already serious. In 2019, at 46 years old, event set designer Kethlyn Ortiz discovered she had skin cancer after noticing a small spot. When the symptoms first appeared, she delayed seeking help because she thought it was something harmless.

"At first, when it started itching, I thought it was just a fungal infection and did not pay attention. I tried to treat it myself with ointments, but I noticed it was getting worse. That is when I decided to seek medical help."



During her first appointment, the doctor ruled out a simple infection and requested a biopsy and an ultrasound to determine the extent of the disease. "From the beginning, she warned me that it could be skin cancer or even breast cancer. I was shaken when she said the tumor could already be advanced because I had waited so long to get help."

Kethlyn shared how she reacted to the diagnosis. "When I received the diagnosis, it was hard to accept. But because of my faith, I knew exactly where to turn since I already knew the Lord Jesus. I had lost my mother to breast cancer, so I prayed that I would not have the same outcome."

The biopsy confirmed that she had advanced skin cancer. Doctors later concluded that the disease had likely been in her body since 2013, even though she



only discovered it years later.

She went through extremely difficult and even humiliating moments.

"The hardest times were when I looked at my shirts soaked in blood because the wound would not stop bleeding. There was a period when I only wore dark shirts to hide it."

Even in those moments, she did not give up. Her wedding was approaching, and she wanted to seal her union at God's altar.

Her condition became critical, and she had to undergo emergency surgery. She and her future husband remained strong in faith and continued fighting for her life.

"I had been attending the Universal Church for a long time. I did not understand why God allowed this to happen, but even so, we kept going to the healing meetings. I anointed myself with blessed oil and cried out to God every day. Despite the negative reports, I stayed firm in my faith."

The situation became even more difficult because it happened during the peak of the COVID 19 pandemic. In July 2020, Kethlyn underwent surgery, and in September of that same year, she celebrated her wedding at the altar of God. Sadly, in 2021, her husband passed away due to COVID 19.

"It was not easy, but his presence during my hardest moments was a gift from

God. He stood by me and supported me through everything. I know that only the Holy Spirit gave me the strength to endure so much pain at once.” Still in 2020, after her battle with cancer, a miracle happened. A new biopsy and follow up appointment revealed something unexpected. There was no trace of cancer cells in her body. Kethlyn credits her complete healing to her faith and perseverance in God.

“I turned to the medicine of heaven. The doctors

were surprised because, since the cancer had been in my body for seven years, they expected it to be much worse. Yet it remained limited to the third layer of my skin. One doctor even told me, ‘You must be a very special person.’ I told him that all goodness comes from God. If I am here today, it is by His grace. The word cancer shakes anyone, but I kept my faith firm on the altar because I knew my victory would come from there. Today, my skin is as soft as a baby’s.”

He survived after being shot twice in the head



served three years and seven months, but even while on parole, he went back to trafficking. In May last year, a rival group ambushed him. During all that time, I kept praying for him,” Sheyla explains.

One night, she and her husband received a call saying that Igor had been shot twice in the head and once in his right hand.

“They told us to come right away to authorize the surgery. On the way, my husband asked, ‘Are we going there just to identify his body?’ But I was sure that was not the case. When we arrived, the social worker told us to prepare for the worst, but I kept praying,” she recalls.

The world of drug trafficking is dangerous. Anyone who gets involved often ends up on a path of violence that can lead to prison or even death. That was the path taken by Igor, 23. It all started when he accepted his first line of cocaine from a friend. Soon after, alcohol and marijuana became part of his life. By the age of 16, without ever having worked, he was already dealing drugs to support his addiction. The hardest part was that his family had no idea. “I only realized something was wrong when the school called and said Igor was not attending classes. He did not use drugs at home, but he would spend nights out. When the police stopped

The surgery was successful. “The shots affected the left side of his body, and he will still need another surgery to place a prosthesis. He stayed in the hospital for 50 days. He had seizures, could barely speak, could not walk, and even had COVID 19, but his mind was still functioning. I kept praying for God to save his soul, and I would bring the anointed oil from the Universal Church to bless him,” she says. After returning home, Igor started physical therapy and slowly learned to walk again.

“I woke up three days after the surgery. The only thing I remember is seeing a black car pass by and asking God to help me when I heard the gunshots. Two other people were shot, and I was the only one who survived. God heard my mother’s prayers and saved me. So I made a commitment to Him, got baptized, and joined the Youth Power Group,” Igor shares.

For mothers going through similar situations, Sheila shares this message: “Never give up on your child. As long as there is life, there is hope. God is a God of miracles. People think they can change on their own, but they cannot. You have to believe in His power.”

him and asked me if I knew he had been stealing, that was when everything came to light. We talked to him, but nothing changed,” says his mother, Sheila Azevedo Costa Andrade.

Later, Igor moved elsewhere to live with a friend. At 18, the police arrested him for drug trafficking. “He was sentenced to ten years in prison. He




I was released, I went to church, but at first I did not accept the help. I believed no one could change

my situation. One day, I learned that God could truly set me free. Little by little, I committed myself to the chain of prayers and received the help I needed.






Angels of the night helping those in need in Miami

People received the support with gratitude and joy. You could see it on their faces, a sense of relief and a renewed sense of hope. It was more than a kind gesture. It was love in action.


The Angels of the Night continue their work with dedication, returning again and again, committed to lifting up the community and bringing light into difficult moments.




