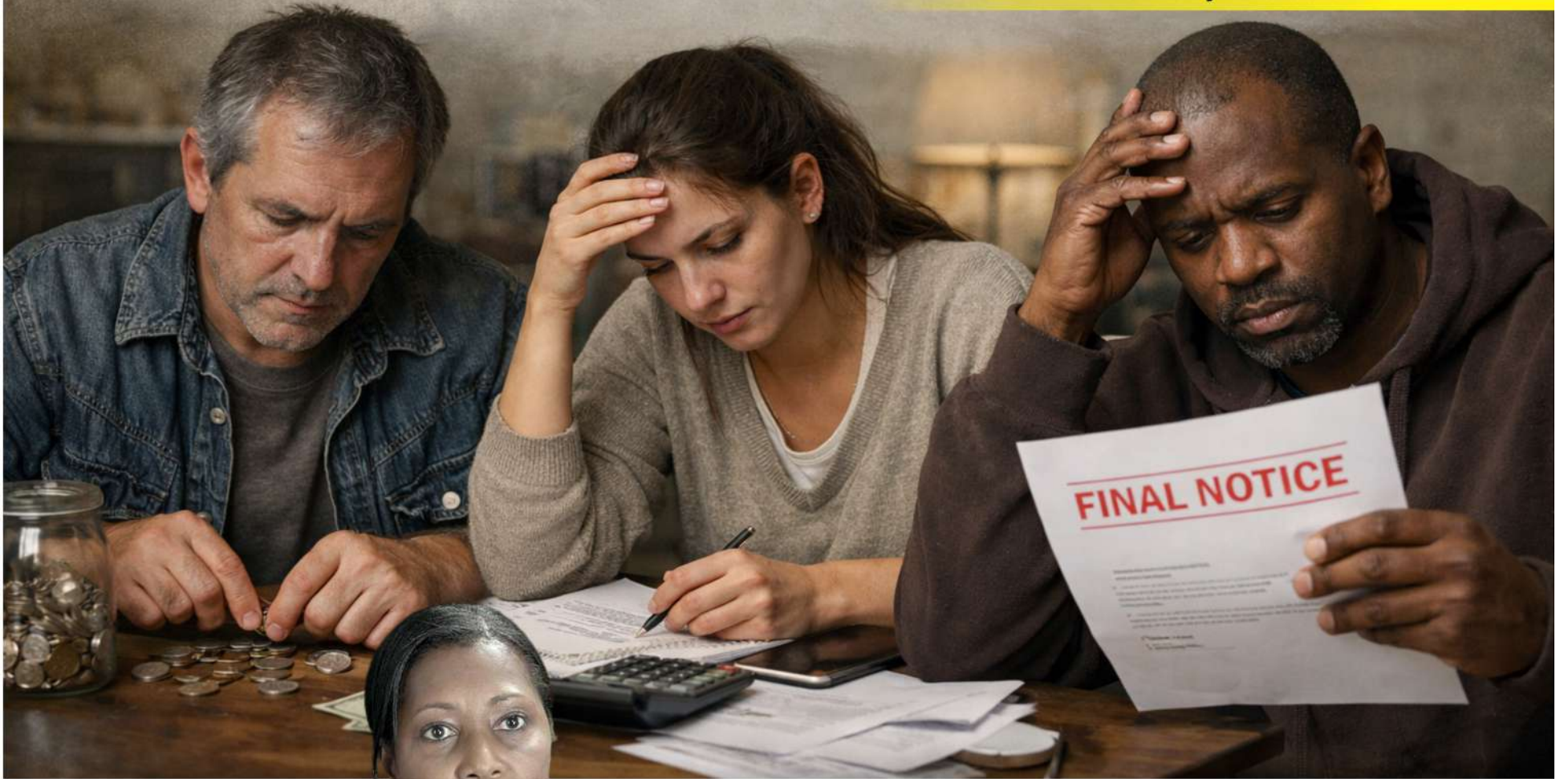

“The Lord bless you and keep you

She had a malignant tumor

At the beginning of 2025, Cleonice, 42, received a diagnosis of a malignant tumor in her intestine after months of severe cramping and diarrhea. At first, she thought it was lactose intolerance, but further tests confirmed it was tubular adenocarcinoma. The news brought shock and tears, but she chose not to let the diagnosis shake her faith. She decided to keep fighting.

After meeting with specialists, doctors determined that she needed surgery to remove part of her intestine. While she followed medical advice, Cleonice also strengthened her faith through prayer. She attended services at the



Universal Church and used her faith with the blessed water, drinking it daily and praying specifically for her healing. Even during difficult emotional moments, she held on to her faith and declared every day that she would overcome the illness.

The surgery was successful, although her recovery was not easy. In the end, the doctors removed the tumor completely, and the tests confirmed there was no spread of the cancer. Today, Cleonice is cancer free and living a normal life. She shares her testimony with gratitude, saying she trusted God and believes He brought her healing.

The sense of powerlessness



Imagine you are driving a car. Everything seems fine. The road is clear, the weather is perfect, and the vehicle is in good condition. Suddenly, you lose control, and what was once calm turns into a frightening situation. Panic sets in as you face the reality of what is happening. In moments like this, we feel powerless, fully aware that control has slipped from our hands.

Life can feel the same way. It is not unusual to face challenges that leave us feeling helpless, unable to direct our own circumstances. This sense of powerlessness can come from sickness, financial struggles, family problems, addiction, depression, spiritual attacks, or other difficult situations.

The book of Exodus gives a clear example of this. The Egyptians oppressed the people of Israel, leaving them enslaved and without control for many years until they cried out to God for help.

“And the Lord said: ‘I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt and have heard their

cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows. So I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up from that land to a good and spacious land, to a land flowing with milk and honey.’”

Exodus 3:7 to 8

God revealed Himself as a Savior to His people then, and He wants to do the same for you today. God does not change, and He continues to seek those who desire a relationship with Him.

When financial struggles threaten the soul

Financial struggles can affect more than just your bank account. They can impact your health, your relationships, and your overall well-being. For many people, living beyond their means or drowning in debt leads to constant stress and anxiety. In this testimony, one member shares how her financial difficulties left her in debt, led to severe depression, and how her faith in God ultimately transformed her life.



Even though I was a member of the church, I struggled with my finances for nearly five years. I had a good job and earned a decent salary, which allowed me to live in an expensive apartment and buy whatever I wanted. Over time, however, I started living beyond my means. I bought expensive furniture and clothes, and soon I could no longer pay my bills on time. I found myself drowning in debt.

My salary disappeared quickly. I could not pay my rent or even buy food, so I kept borrowing money. Out of desperation, I turned to cash loans and loan sharks. Many times, I could not repay what I owed, and the constant pressure left me anxious and overwhelmed.

The weight of my financial situation began to affect my mental health. Every month, as I struggled to make ends meet, I felt more hopeless. Eventually, the stress led to severe depression and a mental breakdown. My family became deeply concerned and took me to a psychiatric hospital, where I was diagnosed with bipolar disorder. I stayed there for a month and received treatment and support.

Although I already attended the Universal Church, I realized I had not truly put into practice what I had learned. That breakdown became a wake-up call. After I was discharged, I went back to church, spoke with the pastor, and asked for guidance. I made a decision to take my spiritual life seriously and began to pray for change. I joined the Chain of Prayer for financial blessings and started attending Sunday services consistently to grow closer to God.

At church, I learned to surrender my worries about finances to God and to trust Him completely. I began applying the Word of God in my daily life and committed myself to following His will in every area.

This renewed faith brought real change. Today, I am debt free, self-employed, and confident in God’s provision. My life has completely changed since I placed my financial worries in His hands. Now I live with hope, purpose, and gratitude for all the support that helped me along the way.

If you are facing financial struggles today, know that you are not alone. Just as I learned, when you surrender your worries to God and seek guidance in His Word, true transformation can happen. "I grew up on a ranch with very little hope and many limitations. Looking for a better life, I left my parents' home at a young age and started working. But my income only covered my basic expenses. I could not pursue any of my goals because I had nothing saved to invest. Even if I worked my whole life, I believed I would never be able to buy a house.

I had no vision for the future. I felt empty inside. To deal with the physical and emotional exhaustion, I turned to alcohol. Since I was living paycheck to paycheck and had no hope of improving my life, I spent what I earned on drinking."

When I first came to the Universal Church, I found hope in God's promises. But I was not consistent and still wanted to do things my own way. Even when I returned later to seek God, my life did not change because my focus was only on receiving blessings.

I opened two restaurants, but both led me into debt. I thought about giving

up, but I kept going because I wanted something better. That was when I realized I needed to prioritize the Holy Spirit above everything else.

I surrendered my past, my present, and my future to God. I gave Him my fears, my pain, and my dreams. I told Him, "Even if I receive nothing, I just want to be with You until the end." That was when I truly surrendered, and that was when I received His presence.

From that moment on, I had peace, even in the middle of problems. Through my faith, my financial life improved, and I also got married. Today, I have a blessed family. My wife and I have been able to buy new cars and a house, and we now own four restaurants. But what truly fulfills me is the Holy Spirit, because He assures me that He is always with me.

God honored His Word when I chose to trust Him and live by it. Now, the first thing I do every day is seek Him in prayer. When I feel weak, the Holy Spirit strengthens me. In my business, I act with integrity and treat people with compassion. I even pray for those who wrong me.

"I made a proposal to the bank to pay a certain amount and have the rest of the debt canceled. The bank accepted, and I was able to clear all my debts. My company began to grow. I bought the car I wanted and two motorcycles for my business. God honored my faith in His Word. Today, I have the Holy Spirit, and I serve God by winning souls and helping those who suffer."

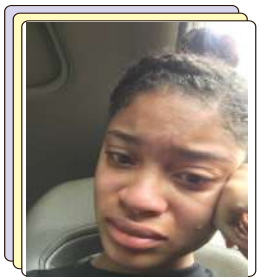
Burdened by bank debt, Madaline felt stuck and unable to move forward. This situation affected every area of her life.

You can get out of debt

Anyone observing the calm demeanor of 50-year-old businessman Samuel Fujimoto would never imagine that he once carried a debt of over 40,000 dollars. His financial troubles began after a traumatic divorce in late 1998. "I held a deep resentment toward my ex-wife. I was not thinking about my debts at all. I had credit card debt and a mortgage on my apartment," he recalls. A lack of financial planning caused his overdue bills to keep growing.

Unsure of what to do, Samuel began attending meetings at the Universal Church. His goal was to find peace and a way out of his struggles. "I came to the Universal meetings seeking an encounter with God and healing in my love life," he says. There, he learned how to let go of resentment and met his future wife. However, his debts continued to increase.

Tightening the belt

At the time, in the early 2000s, Samuel was working at a public bank. Even with the stability of a monthly salary, he chose to resign. "I had just received a promotion, but I felt a different direction from God and decided to leave. My colleagues thought I had lost my mind, but my wife supported me," he recalls.

Samuel did not work for two months. During that period, he and his wife moved out of their rented apartment and lived with his parents rent free to reduce expenses. They also changed their spending habits and cut out nonessential purchases such as eating out and buying clothes they did not need. "We reduced our expenses to the minimum and lived on a very strict budget, never spending beyond our means," he says.

A fresh start

Next, Samuel started working in printer cartridge refilling. He began the business in a spare room at his parents' home. "God gave me the idea to work with ink. Many of my relatives thought I had lost my mind, and I had to face criticism. However, within a month, I secured a major contract with a government agency," he explains.

Debts paid off

With income coming in, his first step was to organize his household budget. Then he contacted banks and creditors to renegotiate his debts. "I made calls, kept negotiating, and asked for discounts. I was able to secure enough funds to pay off my debts in full, upfront, and at a reduced amount. My advice is to always negotiate. You can often get



discounts of up to 70 percent," he shares.

His business continued to grow. "I began attending seminars at the Universal Church. With God's guidance and consistent effort, we expanded the business and bought the home of our dreams along with a few cars," he says.

Today, he works in the IT field, specializing in printer rentals, laptop sales, and maintenance services. "We now own a three-story building and have several employees. I am grateful for everything God has done in our lives," concludes Samuel, who has a 12-year-old daughter and an 8-year-old son.

Today, my financial life is blessed, and it continues to grow. I own a residential care facility with 20 beds. I also own land, including more than 20 acres that has increased greatly in value. I have property for a trucking business, and we operate in several states, including Pennsylvania, Texas, Arkansas, and Louisiana. We go wherever there is work.

There was a time when I thought I could do



everything on my own, but I was wrong. When I chose to trust God and depend on Him in everything, my life changed completely. Today, we own multiple properties, and we are even preparing to open a daycare center.

Things were not easy in my life. I was depressed and had no financial stability. My children did not have proper clothes. I was a single mother, and their father refused to help. He would not pay child support and even threatened to hurt me if I took legal action.

I lived in public housing surrounded by crime, drugs, and poverty. It was not something you read about. It was something I saw every single day. Life felt overwhelming. There were moments when I cried out to God, not knowing how I would ever get out of that situation or provide for my children and myself. I still had rent to pay, and I had no idea where the money would come from. I went to church faithfully every Sunday, but nothing seemed to change. Years went by, and I saw other people sharing testimonies. I started asking myself, where is my testimony? I became frustrated and even angry about my situation.

Then something began to change inside me. God started placing a thought in my mind that sooner or later I would leave that place. Little by little, I began to see Him opening doors. I moved out of public housing into an apartment, then to another place, and eventually I was able to buy a house. I got married, but even with those achievements, something was still missing.

At that point, I realized I needed more than material blessings. I became hungry to truly know God. I wanted to understand the Holy Spirit that everyone talked about. I stopped asking for material things and prayed for one thing only. I asked God to come into my life. When I received the Holy Spirit, everything changed. I felt a peace that I had never experienced before. I began reaching out to people I had hurt and asked for forgiveness because I had carried so much anger inside me. As I let go of that anger, I felt true peace for the first time.

When I walked into the Universal Church, no one judged me. No one looked down on me. For the first time in my life, I felt accepted.

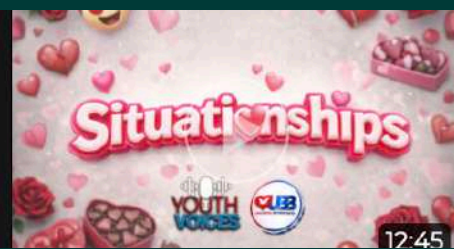
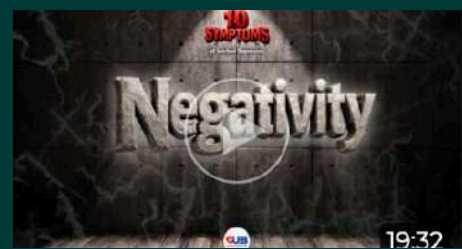
I paid close attention to the services and sought guidance afterward. Everything I was taught, I put into practice.
